

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-08**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM VEHICLE SPEED LIMIT ON  
WILLIAM D. JONES BOULEVARD**

**Whereas**, the City of Fayetteville is awaiting State-approval to begin a long-anticipated reconfiguration and rebuilding of William D. Jones Boulevard from its intersection with William Battle Boulevard to its northern-most terminus at West Washington Street; and

**Whereas**, concerns exist regarding the safe speeds at which vehicles travel along William D. Jones Boulevard from its intersection with William Battle Boulevard to its northern-most terminus at West Washington Street in its present condition; and

**Whereas**, Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-8-153(c)(2) confers upon the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Fayetteville the power to prescribe lower speed limits on municipal streets not designated as state highways in the City of Fayetteville; and

**Whereas**, the Board deems it appropriate to reduce the maximum allowable limit at which vehicles may travel along William D. Jones Boulevard from its intersection with William Battle Boulevard to its northern terminus at West Washington Street.

**Therefore**, Be It Ordained by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Fayetteville that the vehicle speed limit on William D. Jones Boulevard from its intersection with William Battle Boulevard to its northern terminus at West Washington Street shall be 20 miles per hour.

The adoption of this ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
