

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-14
CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, TENNESSEE

Swimming Pool and Spa Code

An ordinance of the City of Fayetteville adopting the 2018 edition of the *International Swimming Pool and Spa Code*, regulating and governing the design, construction, alteration, movement, renovation, replacement, repair and maintenance of swimming pools, spas, hot tubs, aquatic facilities and related equipment in the City of Fayetteville; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor.

The Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Fayetteville do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a certain document, one (1) copy of which is on file in the office of the Planning and Codes Enforcement Department of the City of Fayetteville, being marked and designated as the *International Swimming Pool and Spa Code*, 2018 edition, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Pool and Spa Code of the City of Fayetteville in the State Of Tennessee for regulating and governing the design, construction, alternation, movement, renovation, replacement, repair and maintenance of swimming pools, spas, hot tubs, aquatic facilities and related equipment as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Pool and Spa Code on file in the office of the City of Fayetteville are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part thereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

Section 2. The following sections are hereby revised:

Section 101.1. **City of Fayetteville**

Section 105.6.2. **Schedule of permit fees as adopted by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Fayetteville, Ordinance No. 2006-8.**

Section 105.6.3. **75%, 50%**

Section 107.4. **Code Violation, \$50 a day, one (1) day**

Section 107.5. **\$50.00, \$50.00**

Section 3. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 4. That nothing in this ordinance or in the Pool and Spa Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 3 of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this ordinance.


Section 5. That the City Administrator is hereby ordered and directed to cause this ordinance to be published.
