RESOLUTION TO REPEAL AND REPLACE THE PERSONNEL POLICY ADOPTED MARCH 14, 2017 WITH THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE PERSONNEL RULES (PERSONNEL POLICY).

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville Personnel Policy most recently adopted by Board action on March 14, 2017; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Personnel Policy are needed in order to remain current with changing and emerging employment statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville, through the office of the City Administrator, has worked in conjunction with the University of Tennessee Municipal Technical Advisory Service to craft an updated Personnel Rules (Personnel Policy); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville Board of Mayor and Aldermen have reviewed the updated Personnel Rules (Personnel Policy); and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Fayetteville that the prior Board action on the Personnel Policy of March 14, 2017 is hereby repealed and is replaced with Resolution R-2020-10 adopting the City of Fayetteville Personnel Rules (Personnel Policy).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
