Whereas, it is appropriate that the members of this Board of Mayor and Aldermen should honor Dr. Janine M. Wilson who has performed with exceptional commitment to the education of students in Fayetteville-Lincoln County and has strived to leave a positive imprint on her community and world; and

Whereas, Dr. Janine M. Wilson is one such honorable person; and

₩hereas, Dr. Wilson received a Psychology degree from the University of Tennessee in 1973 and completed her education degree in 1975 with a Bachelor of Science in Speech and Hearing; and

₩hereas, Dr. Wilson continued her devotion to educational learning at Tennessee State University where she received her Master of Education in Administration and Supervision in 1982 and later returned to complete her Doctor of Education with a major in Administration and Supervision in 2001; and

₩hereas, Dr. Wilson began her career teaching eighth grade math at Central Junior High; and

##hereas, Dr. Wilson served as a Principal for twelve years in Lincoln County at Petersburg School and assisted in the opening of the new Unity School; and

Whereas, Dr. Wilson was named the Assistant Director of Schools in 1999 for Fayetteville City Schools; and

##hereas, Dr. Wilson was appointed to the Fayetteville Public Utilities Board in 2007 and elected Chairman of the FPU board in 2009, working with CEO Britt Dye and the members of the board to substantially improve the infrastructure of the Water and Wastewater system, until leaving the board in June of 2017; and

₩hereas, Dr. Wilson was appointed Director of Schools for Fayetteville City Schools in 2010. During Dr. Wilson's tenure, she worked with the Fayetteville City School System Board to establish the new city high school and nurtured life-long relationships with the students that attended Ralph Askins Elementary, Fayetteville Middle School, and Fayetteville High School; and

₩hereas, Dr. Wilson will retire on December 31, 2020 with 43 years serving in education in Lincoln County and for the City of Fayetteville; and

##hereas, Dr. Wilson and her husband, Eddie, reside in Lincoln County and enjoy spending time with their children, Courtney and Rebecca, and their grandchildren; now, therefore,
