

**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE
FAYETTEVILLE ADA TRANSITION PLAN**

WHEREAS, The Tennessee Department of Transportation notified all cities and counties with (50) employees or more in November of 2016, they must have an ADA Transition Plan and Self Evaluation in place in order to continue to receive Transportation Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville Board of Mayor and Aldermen entered into contract with Community Development Partners, to complete an ADA Transition Plan for the City of Fayetteville that meets all the requirements of the Tennessee Department of Transportation and the Federal Highways Administration Tennessee Division concerning ADA Transition Plans; and

WHEREAS, the public was afforded several opportunities to provide input into the planning process including public input surveys, advisory committee meetings, public notices, and a review period for a draft version of the ADA Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City ADA Coordinator, City Administrator, Mayor, and Aldermen have reviewed and provided input and assistance with development of the ADA Plan,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Fayetteville Board of Mayor and Aldermen as follows,

THAT, the Fayetteville Board of Mayor and Aldermen does hereby adopt the Fayetteville Tennessee ADA Self-Evaluation & Transition Plan.
