WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Transportation has responsibility for the administration of the Tennessee Department of Transportation Multimodal Access Fund program which is designed to assist communities in their efforts to enhance transportation concerns.

THAT, Mayor Michael Whisenant, is hereby authorized to execute and submit an application with appropriate assurances to the State of Tennessee, Department of Transportation, requesting Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Multimodal Access funds for the City of Fayetteville.

THAT, the City of Fayetteville will be responsible for the local cash /match toward the project to be provide in full by the general account; and

THAT, Michael Whisenant be and is hereby designated and appointed as Financial Officer and to perform on behalf of the City of Fayetteville, Tennessee, those acts and assume such duties as are consistent with said position.
