## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-07**

## A RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC ENTITY PARTNERS "SAFETY PARTNERS" MATCHING GRANT AND APPROVING FUNDS FOR MATCHING GRANT.

WHEREAS, a need exists for employees of the City of Fayetteville to have safety equipment to perform the functions of their jobs; and

WHEREAS, the City's worker's compensation carrier, Public Entity Partners, provides a matching grant program known as "Safety Partners" whereby Public Entity Partners will reimburse up to fifty (50) percent of the cost of approved safety-related items to be used by City employees; and

WHEREAS, City personnel seek to take advantage of the "Safety Partners" matching grant program to purchase safety eyewear, leather work gloves and reflective safety vests; and

WHEREAS, application for the grant requires a resolution from the Board of Mayor and Aldermen that the City approves the application and will provide the funds for the purchase of such items for which the program will provide a reimbursement of up to fifty (50) percent.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, TENNESSEE, THAT:

- (1) Authority is hereby given for application to be made to Public Entity Partners for grant proceeds under the "Safety Partners" Matching Grant Program.
- (2) Authority is further given for the City to provide funds not to exceed \$4,299.30 if the grant is awarded with the understanding that up to fifty (50) percent of said amount will be reimbursed by the grant.
