

RESOLUTION R-2022-12

Reallocation of Animal Control Operations Funds to Animal Control Building

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville (Tennessee) adopted a **\$75,000** allocation in its 2022-2023 Budget to be used for animal control operations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville did not have any expenditures from this line item during the first quarter of the FY which resulted in **\$18,750** in savings; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville (Tennessee) has found that the building jointly owned by the City of Fayetteville and Lincoln County, Tennessee which currently houses the animal control operations for both the City and the County has major maintenance problems particularly with the electrical and plumbing; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to use the amount of savings not to exceed the **\$18,750** to be reallocated to address those priorities only with electrical and plumbing maintenance, and these expenses will be equally shared with the County, and follow those State of Tennessee procurement practices/standards.


