WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville (Tennessee) was a beneficiary of The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) which created the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to provide economic stimulus for states, municipalities, counties, tribes, and territories; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville received \$2,090,939.77 in two funding cycles; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville has elected to accept the \$10,000,000 Revenue Loss allowance; and

WHEREAS, eligible fund usage includes, but not limited to government services, including premium payments to those performing government services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Fayetteville Board of Mayor and Aldermen that a one-time payment of \$500 will be made to current employees prior to the close of the 2022 calendar year who were employed by the City on or before September 30, 2022 and who average working a minimum of 30 hours weekly.
