WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville, Tennessee has received 2017 Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) funds from the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) in the amount of \$1,779,220.; and

WHEREAS, on November 29, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. C.S.T., the City of Fayetteville received competitive bids for the 2017 TAP Phase II -- Stone Bridge Park to Camp Blount Connector Project; and

WHEREAS, a total of <u>two (2)</u> bid packages were received, opened, and read aloud; and

WHEREAS, the bidders with their respective bids were as follows:

Base Bid

Adams Contracting, LLC

\$3,492,399.40

Dement Construction Co., LLC

\$3,309,770.00

WHEREAS, additional funds will be needed to complete the connector project as proposed in the 2017 TAP application and contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Fayetteville Board and Mayor of Aldermen as follows:

THAT, the City of Fayetteville will request additional grant funds from TDOT; and

THAT, once the City has a determination from TDOT as to whether additional grant funds may be obtained from TDOT to fund this project, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen will revisit the feasibility of accepting the bid of Dement Construction Co., LLC.
