A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE FIRE DEPARMENT TO APPLY FOR STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND

EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) GRANT

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has established the

Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Grant program; and

WHEREAS, local fire departments may apply for grant funding to be used for recruitment

and retention of fire department personnel; and

WHEREAS, if awarded funding from the grant and subject to the approval of the Board of

Mayor and Aldermen once the matching terms are established, the Fire Department anticipates

using the grant funds toward the cost of training and equipping newly hired Fire Department

personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, be it resolved by the Board of

Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Fayetteville, Tennessee, that the Fire Department of the city

of Fayetteville is hereby authorized to seek and apply for all available funding from the Staffing

for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant program. Once the terms any

potential grant are known, the Board will take further action to accept or decline the grant proceeds.
