TO SEEK ANIMAL FRIENDLY GRANT**


WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee has allocated funds to the Tennessee Department of Agriculture's Animal Health Division from the sales of *Animal Friendly – Spay and Neuter Saves Lives* specialty license plates to provide funding for spay and neuter services; and

WHEREAS, the Fayetteville Lincoln County Animal Control department seeks to apply for grant funding from said program; and

WHEREAS, if awards, such funds are anticipated to be used to fund spay and neuter animals in the care of the Fayetteville Lincoln County Animal Control department.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, be it resolved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Fayetteville, Tennessee, that the Fayetteville Lincoln County Animal Control department is hereby authorized to seek and apply for all available funding from the State of Tennessee Department of Agriculture's Animal Friendly Grants program.
