A RESOLUTION to recognize the 2022 Fayetteville High School Tiger Football Team on the occasion of their 2022 season which resulted in the winning of the 2022 Tennessee Secondary School Athletic Association Division 1 Class A Region V Football Championship.

Alderman should honor those citizens who have performed with uncommon commitment and have achieved exceptional success in their areas of focus; and

#hereas, the Fayetteville High School Football Team, is one such estimable group who as a Senior group posted a four-year record of 46 and 5 which included four region titles and a state championship; and

₩hereas, the 2022 Fayetteville High School Tigers Football Team, having finished a perfect 10 and 0 regular season, holding a number 1 ranking for six weeks of the regular season, and having seven players make the Region V-1A All Region Team, four players receive Region V-1A All Region Team Honorable Mention, while also having team members named as Region V-1A Special Teams Player of the Year, two players named as Co-Defensive Players of the Year, Lineman of the year, two players named as Co-Offensive players of the year, Coach of the Year, Coaching Staff of the Year, and a Tennessee 1A Mr. Football nominee. They recorded 4,943 total yards with a pass completion percentage of 68.8%, and scored 73 touch downs and only allowed 18 total touchdowns scored by other teams while also racking up 23 sacks on the season, while maintaining a team academic average of 3.33; and

Whereas, Fayetteville High School completed the season with four players participating in the East/West All Star Game, and one who participated in the Nashville All American Bowl, and five players who signed to play with colleges after graduation, and
