A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE TO APPLY FOR

FUNDING FOR PURCHASE OF TOWER FIRE TRUCK

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Agriculture Community Facilities Loan/Grant

Program (USDA) provides financing to governmental entities for the purchase of equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville Fire Department seeks to replace its existing tower

truck and desires to make an application to USDA for a financing loan and any available grants;

and

WHEREAS, application for financing can be made with the USDA for the purchase of the

tower truck which, if granted, would involve financing over a 20-year term at a fixed interest rate

of 3.875% or less, as well as the potential for receiving a grant of up to \$50,000.00 from the lender

to cover costs and fees incurred in such a loan.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, be it resolved by the Board of

Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Fayetteville, Tennessee, that the City of Fayetteville is hereby

authorized to apply for financing of a tower truck with USDA. The Mayor is hereby authorized

and directed to execute and submit an application to the USDA Community Facilities Loan/Grant

Program and to enter into all necessary agreements to receive and administer such grant funds.
