

## Fillmore County Absentee Ballot Process

The General Election will be November 3, 2020 in Fillmore County. Absentee Ballot voting runs from September 18 through November 2, 2020.

The Fillmore County Auditor/Treasurer's Office will be providing absentee balloting services to Fillmore County residents starting September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and ending on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020.

### **Absentee Voting Hours:**

- Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Saturday, October 31, 2020 – 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Monday, November 2, 2020 – 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- You can hand-deliver absentee or mail in ballots at the Fillmore County Courthouse during open business hours until November 2, 2020

The Fillmore County Auditor/Treasurer's Office will be accepting ballots through the mail up to 7 days after the election as long as they are postmarked by November 3<sup>rd</sup>.
