#### FILLMORE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' MINUTES

This is a preliminary draft of the February 2, 2021, minutes as interpreted by the Clerk of the Board for use in preparing the official minutes. It is expected that there will be corrections, additions, and/or omissions before the final minutes are reviewed and officially approved by the County Board.

The Board of County Commissioners of Fillmore County, Minnesota met in special session this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of February, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Board Room, Fillmore County Courthouse, in the City of Preston.

The following members were present: Commissioners Marc Prestby, Larry Hindt, Randy Dahl, Mitch Lentz and Duane Bakke; Bobbie Hillery, Administrator/Clerk; Ron Gregg, Highway; Brent Kohn, Highway; Cristal Adkins, Zoning; Kristina Kohn, Human Resources; and Karen Reisner, Fillmore County Journal.

Present via WebEx: Kristine Oman, Accounting Technician; Jessica Erickson, Public Health; Brett Corson, Fillmore County Attorney; Kevin Olson, Social Services; Andrew Hatzenbihler, Sanitation; John DeGeorge, Sheriff; Chris Hahn, CEDA; Jason Marquardt, Veteran's Services; Jason McCaslin, Assessor; Gretchen Mensink-Lovejoy; Matt Hilgart, AMC Representative; Representative Greg Davids; Senator Jeremy Miller; and Bonita Underbakke.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

On motion by Bakke and seconded by Lentz, the agenda was unanimously approved with the addition of the request to hire roster nurses.

On motion by Prestby and seconded by Hindt, the Board unanimously approved the following Consent Agenda:

- 1. January 26, 2021 County Board minutes
- 2. Renewal of Consumption and Display Permit Eagle Bluff ELC for the period of April 1, 2021 through April 1, 2022

On motion by Hindt and seconded by Bakke, the Board unanimously approved the Commissioners' Warrants.

The Finance Department warrants were reviewed.

Ron Gregg and Brett Kohn, Highway were present.

Discussion ensued regarding rotation of vehicles for the Highway Department, specifications needed for the vehicles and types of vehicles available, including engine type, for state bids.

On motion by Bakke and seconded by Hindt, the Board unanimously approved the purchase of a Flame Red 2021 Dodge for the Fillmore County Highway Department from the State Contract from Dodge of Burnsville at a cost of not to exceed \$28,300, it was noted that the color change and the smaller gas tank were the changes made by the board from the recommended bid.

The Citizen's Input portion of the meeting opened and closed at 9:39 a.m.as no one was present to speak.

On motion by Prestby and seconded by Lentz, the Board unanimously awarded Minnowa Construction for the Bridge Replacement Project in Sumner Township, Project SAP 023-599-209, for the low bid of \$177,326.96.

On motion by Bakke and seconded by Hindt, the Board unanimously awarded Minnowa Construction for the Bridge Replacement Project in Carimona Township, Project SAP 023-599-205, for the low bid of \$275,947.32.

#### FILLMORE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' MINUTES

On motion by Lentz and seconded by Prestby, the Board unanimously adopted: **RESOLUTION 2021-006**: Final payment to ICON Constructors for the Land Bridge SAP 023-605-038 at a total cost of \$64,623.96.

The Chair recessed the meeting at 9:55 a.m. and resumed back in session at 10:00 a.m.

Fillmore County's Legislative Priorities were reviewed.

Senator Miller thanked everyone for all their good work and encouraged everyone to reach out to him with questions or needs.

Representative Davids thanked the County Board and Department Heads for all they do every day.

Kristina Kohn, Human Resource Officer was present.

Human Resources Officer Kohn presented the first reading of the draft changes to the "Probationary Period" policy. She will bring the policy back with the changes as recommended as a second reading.

Human Resources Officer Kohn presented the first reading of the draft updates to the "Mileage Reimbursement & Travel Policy" policy. Discussion was held regarding use of County vehicles and their availability. Some kind of tool to monitor and manage mileage and usage was discussed. She will bring the policy back with the changes as recommended as a first reading again.

On motion by Bakke and seconded by Lentz, the Board unanimously approved the resignation of Jennifer Peterson, Eligibility Worker, effective 2/18/2021. The Board thanked her for her 14 years of service.

On motion by Hindt and seconded by Prestby, the Board unanimously approved the request to recruit roster nurses for COVID clinics.

Bobbie Hillery, County Administrator was present.

On motion by Lentz and seconded by Hindt, the following resolution was unanimously adopted: **RESOLUTION 2021-007:** 11<sup>th</sup> Extension of Declared State of Emergency, extended through March 2, 2021.

Hillery noted that she would be presenting the technology road map that was included in the packet with price quotes for the next Technology/Land Records/GIS meeting on February 16<sup>th</sup>. She noted that the one project missing was the badge readers and cameras for the County Office Building.

The consensus among the Board was to hold the February 23, 2021 Board meeting as an all-virtual meeting due to the Marco installing the audio/visual equipment in the Board room for virtual meetings.

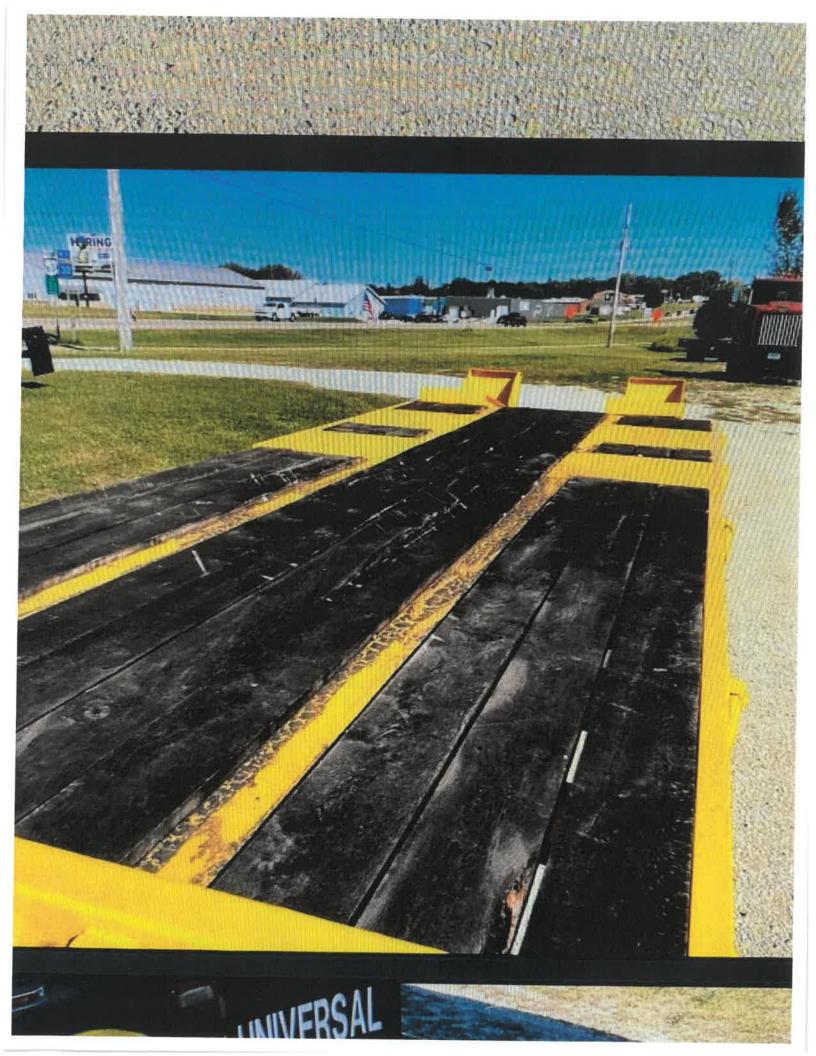

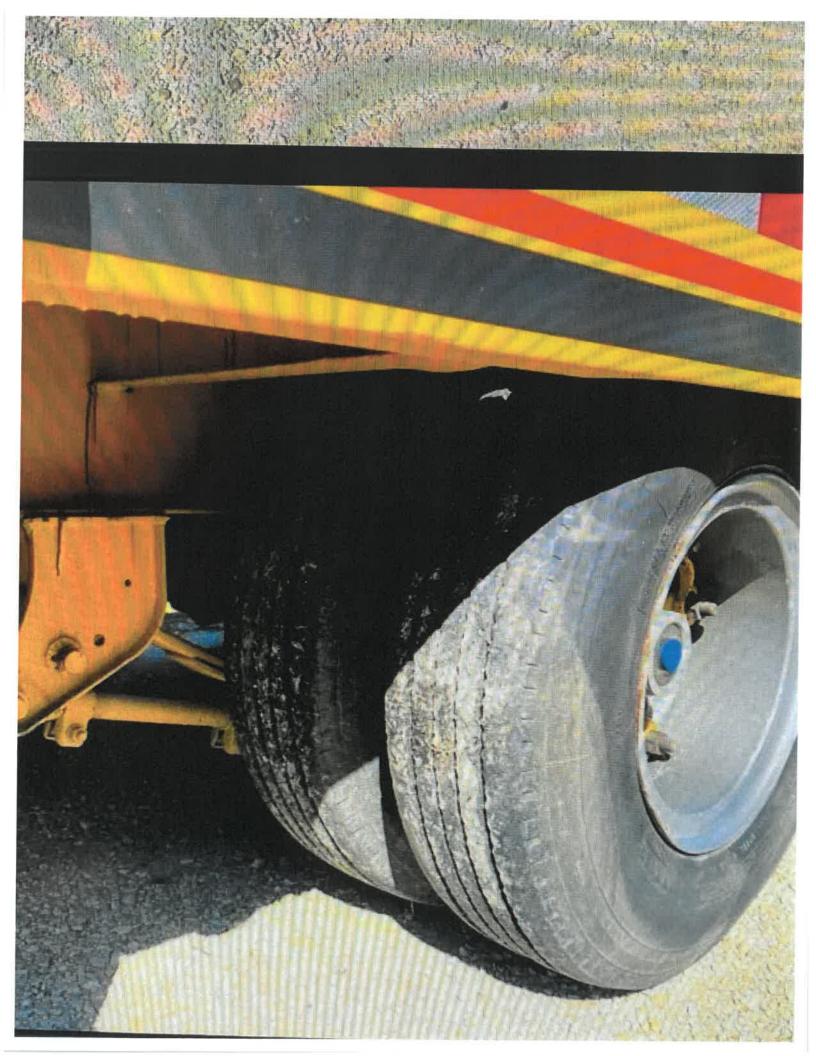

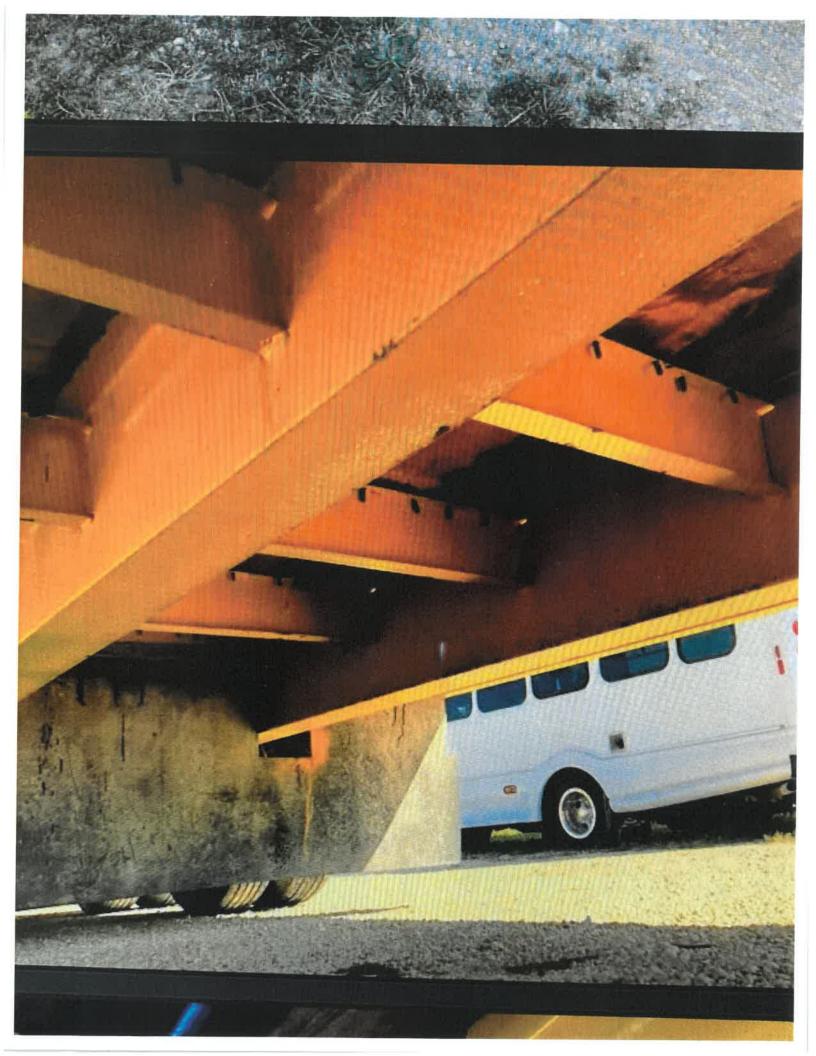

# A. Policy Statement

The probationary or working test period shall be regarded as an extension of the examination process. It shall be used by department heads and supervisors for closely observing the employee's work and rejecting any employee whose performance does not meet the required work standards. This time also enables the new employee to evaluate <a href="theirhis/her">theirhis/her</a> interest in continuing their employment with the County.

#### B. Duration

Effective June 9, 2009, eEmployees hired, re-hired, appointed, transferred to a new position, or promoted shall be required to successfully complete a one (1) yeartwelve (12) month probationary period from the date of employment status change unless federal or state statutes or union contracts require otherwise. Refer to individual laborunion contracts for length of probation information group.

#### C. Extension of Probationary Period

In rare or unusual circumstances or conditions that prevent the making of a full and fair determination as a basis for granting regular status or terminating the employee, a three (3) month extension of the probationary period may be granted. Any request for extension from a department head must be approved by the County Board. This request must be made-by no later than the beginning of the twelfth (12) month by completing a request for Board Action form and submitting it to the Administrator's office. A copy of the request shall be provided to the probationary employee.

#### D. Probationary Performance Evaluation

- 1. A written evaluation indicating the general progression/performance of the employee must be completed by the department head or supervisor at six (6) months of service as well as three (3) weeks prior to completion of the one (1) yeartwelve (12) month probationary probation period.
- The evaluation procedure in the personnel manual shall be followed. Request for Board Action must also be completed and submitted, along with the evaluation form, to the County Coordinator Once the completed probation final evaluation is received by Human Resources, the request for regular status will be placed on the agenda for approval by the Board prior to any change in an employee's employment status.
- 3. The new employee should be properly orientated, and trained and supported so as to be aware of what the standards of performance are for the position and to ensure the employee has what they need to be successful. Each employee should be given every opportunity to have all questions answered regarding work assignments. It is the responsibility of each department head and supervisor to inform the new employee how they are doing during this qualifying period on a regular, ongoing basis.

#### E. Termination

A probationary employee may be terminated at any time during the working test period, if in the department head's opinion; the employee is unable or unwilling to perform the duties of the position satisfactorily.

#### F. Compensation

No raises, except cost of living adjustments, shall be enacted for probationary employees during the working test period unless present in otherwise required by a union contract.

# G. Benefits During the Probationary Period

Leave benefits, as authorized under these policies, shall accrue to the employee during the probationary period, and, once earned, can be used at any time during the probationary period, subject to supervisor/department head's approval. Benefit eligible employees shall receive applicable benefits on the first of the month following their initial date of employmentin which they become eligible.

#### A. Scope

It is the intent of the Fillmore County Board of Commissioners to establish uniform County personnel policies consistent with <u>State and Federalthe</u> laws-of the <u>State of Minnesota which</u>, <u>which</u> promote and insure a spirit of confidence and cooperation between the County Board and its employees.

The following policies shall apply to employees of Fillmore County, and are the minimum standards of procedure for all County employees. These rules must ensure compliance with Merit System standards.

Any conflict between these policies and other authorized guidelines shall be resolved by the controlling boards or commissions and the County Board.

# B. Adoption

- 1. These rules, regulations and policies shall take effect upon adoption by the Fillmore County Board of Commissioners.
- Policies are developed to provide information and direction and are subject to change at any time by the County Board. All changes shall be provided to all department heads, employees and bargaining unit representatives. Employees are responsible for reading, asking any questions needed for full understanding, and signing off on new or updated policies. Completed sign off sheets shall be maintained in the Administrator's Office.

# C. Administration

- 1. These rules shall be administered by the Human Resources Officer under the direction of the County Administrator who shall be accountable to the County Board. The Human Resources Officer under the direction of the County Administrator shall develop and provide the necessary forms, procedures, and instruction for the implementation of these personnel regulations.
- 2. Copies of these rules shall be made available to all employees, other appointing authorities and interested union representatives. Printed copies of these regulations shall be on file in the Administrator's office, and shall be available for public review upon request.

### D. Savings Clause

If any personnel regulation shall be held invalid by judicial or legislative action, the remainder of these rules, other than that which has been held invalid, shall not be affected.

#### E. Departmental Rules

In accordance with these rules each department head may establish departmental rules of procedure, which do not conflict with these rules, to cover unique circumstances. Departmental rules must be approved by the County Board prior to implementation and shall be filed with the Administrator's office.

### F. <u>Disclaimer</u>

In accordance with Minnesota Statute 466.01-466.15 the County Board hereby declares its intent to defend and hold harmless and indemnify any of its officers or employees who are sued in tort action arising out of the performance of their official duties, except where such tort action arises from malfeasance in office which shall be determined by the County Board at a hearing.

# G. Labor Agreements

Those employees who are subject to collective bargaining agreements as negotiated in accordance with the Public Employment Relations Act, M.S. 179.61-179.76, as amended, shall be exempt from the provisions of these rules which are inconsistent with such agreements. Should said collective bargaining agreement not address any regulation or rule of procedure prescribed in the County personnel manual then said employee shall be subject to that regulation or rule of procedure under the County personnel manual.

# H. Management Rights

The County Board retains the full and unrestricted right to operate and manage all manpower, facilities, and equipment; to establish policies and programs; to set and amend budgets; to determine the utilization of technology; to establish and modify the organizational structure; to select, direct, and determine the number of personnel; and to perform all inherent managerial functions not specifically limited by current collective bargaining agreements, these regulations, and County Board resolutions.

<u>APPOINTING AUTHORITY</u> means the County Board of Commissioners or other officer or board authorized by statute or lawfully delegated authority to make appointments to positions under the County policies.

APPOINTMENT means the appointment of an individual to a position within the County.

<u>CLASSIFICATION</u> means the assignment of a position to an appropriate class or grade on the basis of the type, educational requirements, difficulty, decision level and responsibility of the work performed in the position.

**COUNTY BOARD** means the Fillmore County Board of Commissioners.

DAYS mean working days, unless otherwise indicated.

<u>DEMOTION</u> means a change by an employee from a position in one class/grade to a position in another class/grade with less responsible duties and/or a lower salary range.

<u>DEPARTMENT HEAD</u> means a duly elected, appointed or hired county official duly authorized and responsible to supervise the activities of a department or agency under their jurisdiction.

<u>EMPLOYEE</u> means any individual employed by Fillmore County in a position covered by these rules who is paid a salary or wage.

**EMPLOYER** means the Fillmore County Board of Commissioners.

<u>EXEMPT POSITIONS</u> mean positions of a managerial, administrative, or professional nature, or for elected officials, as prescribed by federal and state labor statutes, which are exempt from mandatory overtime payments.

INTERMITTENT EMPLOYMENT includes employees who work on a fluctuating or as needed schedule. There is no guarantee of hours with intermittent employment positions. OR employees whose positions are basically seasonal or temporary in character and 1) are not for more than 67 working days in a calendar year or 2) are not for more than 100 working days in any calendar year, are under 22 years, and are full time students enrolled in a nonprofit or public educational institution prior to being hired and have indicated or intend to continue as a student following the temporary employment.

<u>LAYOFF</u> means the termination of employment because of shortage of funds, curtailment of services or other reason not reflecting negatively on the employee's performance.

<u>MILITARY LEAVE</u> means the leave of absence granted by state law to employees entering active duty or required training in the armed forces of the State of Minnesota or the United States of America.

<u>NON-EXEMPT POSITIONS</u> mean positions of a clerical, technical, or service nature as prescribed by federal and state labor statutes, which are covered by provisions for overtime payments.

<u>REGULAR FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE</u> means an employee who is regularly scheduled to work thirty (30) or more hours per week and who has successfully completed the required probationary period of twelve (12) months in <u>a newly hired/appointed an advertised</u> position.

<u>REGULAR PART-TIME EMPLOYEE</u> means an employee who- regularly works less than thirty (30) hours per week, is not an intermittent employee, and who has successfully completed the required probationary period of twelve (12) months in a <u>competitively obtained</u> position.

<u>PROBATIONARY PERIOD</u> means a working test period of twelve (12) months during which a <u>newly hired or</u> <u>appointed the</u> employee is required to demonstrate their fitness for the position to which they are employed by the actual performance of the duties in the position.

<u>PROMOTION</u> means a change of an employee from a position in one class/grade to a position in another class/grade with more responsible duties and/or a higher salary range.

<u>RECLASSIFICATION</u> means a reassignment—or reclassification of a position by raising it to a higher class of positions, reducing it to a lower class of positions, or moving it to another class of positions at the same level, on the basis of significant changes in the type, difficulty, decision level or responsibility of the work performed in the position.

<u>RESIGNATION</u> means the termination of employment made at the request of an employee.

<u>SUSPENSION</u> means an involuntary leave of absence with or without pay for disciplinary purposes, or for investigation of charges made against an employee.

<u>TEMPORARY FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE</u> means an employee who works thirty (30) or more hours per week for a period not to exceed six (6) consecutive months in a department or employees whose positions are basically seasonal or temporary in character and 1) are not for more than 67 working days in a calendar year or 2) are not for more than 100 working days in any calendar year, are under 22 years, and are full time students enrolled in a nonprofit or public educational institution prior to being hired and have indicated or intend to continue as a student following the temporary employment.

<u>TEMPORARY PART-TIME EMPLOYEE</u> means an employee who works less than thirty (30) hours per week for a period not to exceed six (6) consecutive months per calendar year in a department and includes part-time employees who work the lesser of 14 hours per week or 35 percent of the normal work week in that unit OR employees whose positions are basically seasonal or temporary in character and 1) are not for more than 67 working days in a calendar year or 2) are not for more than 100 working days in any calendar year, are under 22 years, and are full time students enrolled in a nonprofit or public educational institution prior to being hired and have indicated or intend to continue as a student following the temporary employment.

<u>TERMINATION</u> means any separation, whether voluntary or involuntary, of employment from County service.

<u>TRANSFER</u> means a change of an employee from one position to another position in the same grade <u>or the</u> move of an employee into the same position within a different department.

<u>VETERAN</u> means an applicant and employee who is entitled to Veteran's Preference as outlined in M.S. 197.46 et seq. (Veteran's Preference Act)

#### A. Policy Statement

Occasionally, family members of current County employees apply for positions within the County. The County's policy is to hire the best-qualified individual for a position. There are, however, several guidelines which should be followed prior to making a job offer to a family member.

# B. Guidelines

- 1. The term family members will be defined as spouse, child, parent, sister, brother, grandparent, grandchild, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, in-laws or step relative of any aforementioned relationship, or other relationships as determined by the County Board.
- 2. In no instance shall a hiring decision be made which knowingly creates a supervisor/subordinate family member relationship within the same department.
- 3. Generally it is not a good practice to employ a family member within the same department or in a situation where they routinely interact or influence the work of one another.
- 4. All decisions and determinations with regard to the interpretation and effect of hiring a family member of a current employee shall be made by the County Board of Commissioners.
- 5. This policy will not apply retroactively to employees currently employed by the County.
