

PERMIT TO TILE INTO AND THROUGH COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY

_____ in consideration of the right to extend into and through the Right of Way of (County, Road State Aid Highway) _____, located in Section _____ of _____ Township, do hereby agree to do and perform the following required acts pertaining to this permitted activity:

1. Accept complete responsibility for making Gopher One call to check for conflicts with other utilities that might be encountered during this proposed tiling activity.
2. Check with and receive written confirmation from the Soil Conservation Service stating that the activity is acceptable to their office and will not result in drainage from one watershed or sub-watershed to another.
3. Where tiling through the road is required, jack or bore through concrete and bituminous surfaced roads.
4. Place only steel reinforced concrete sewer pipe or steel well casing pipe through the entire width of the roadway (on jacked or bored projects). Trenched projects through gravel roads shall use PVC sewer line SDR 35 under roadway.
5. On trenches through gravel roads, place backfill in lifts not to exceed one foot and thoroughly tamp or compact each layer, including a minimum of 6" depth of gravel or crushed rock surface to the surface of the roadway, leaving the surface smooth for traffic.
6. Fill surface and maintain the tile crossing in a smooth condition for a period of not less than 60 days, or until no further settlement is evidenced, whichever occurs first.
7. If tile is to simply outlet from a field into county right-of-way, reshape and reseed any disturbed right-of-way area and place an identifying marker (ie: channel post with reflective marker) to designate the end of the tile.
8. Accept full responsibility for relocation or repair of tile due to any County road construction or maintenance activities.

Responsibility for safety of traffic is hereby accepted by the owner during this time.
