### FILLMORE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' MINUTES

This is a preliminary draft of the May 12, 2020, minutes as interpreted by the Clerk of the Board for use in preparing the official minutes. It is expected that there will be corrections, additions, and/or omissions before the final minutes are reviewed and officially approved by the County Board.

The Board of County Commissioners of Fillmore County, Minnesota met in regular session this 12<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Board Room, Fillmore County Courthouse, in the City of Preston.

The following member was present: Commissioner Marc Prestby

The following members were present by Webex: Commissioners Larry Hindt, Randy Dahl, Mitch Lentz and Duane Bakke. Also present by Webex were: Bobbie Hillery, Administrator/Clerk; Lori Affeldt, Finance Director; Kristina Kohn, Human Resources; Ron Gregg, Highway Engineer; Andrew Hatzenbihler, Sanitation; Jessica Erickson, Public Health Director; Kevin Olson, Social Services Manager; Brett Corson, County Attorney; Heidi Jones, Auditor/Treasurer; Bonita Underbakke; Gerald Wolf; Gary Harter, Harter Quick Cleanup; and Karen Reisner, Fillmore County Journal.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

On motion by Lentz and seconded by Hindt, the Board unanimously approved the agenda.

On motion by Bakke and seconded by Hindt, the Board unanimously approved the following Consent Agenda: 1. May 5, 2020 County Board minutes

On motion by Lentz and seconded by Hindt, the Board unanimously approved the Commissioners' Warrants.

The Finance Department Warrants were reviewed.

Ron Gregg, Highway & Airport was present.

On motion by Bakke and seconded by Lentz, the Board unanimously approved RESOLUTION 2020-017: Carimona Township Bridge Replacement Project SAP 23-599-197.

On motion by Dahl and seconded by Bakke, the Board unanimously approved signature for the Request for FAA Approval of Agreement for Transfer of Entitlements, which approves the sum of \$75,000 for fiscal years 2017 and 2018 from Fillmore County Airport to the City of Blue Earth, Minnesota, as requested by the County Engineer.

On motion by Dahl and seconded by Hindt, the Board unanimously approved signature for the Agreement for Waiver, Transfer, and Repayment of Federal Airport Entitlement Funds as requested by the County Engineer.

Heidi Jones, Auditor/Treasurer was present.

On motion by Bakke and seconded by Lentz, the Board unanimously approved RESOLUTION 2020-018: Snowmobile Funding for the 2020-2021 snowmobile season.

Heidi Jones, Auditor/Treasurer explained the Northern Natural Gas Tax Court Refund Agreement, noting that at this time the total amount needing to be reimbursed is \$141,306.04. Jones also noted that Northern Natural Gas agreed to allow repayment by subtracting from their 2020 tax payment.

### FILLMORE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' MINUTES

On motion by Dahl and seconded by Bakke, the Board unanimously approved the Agreement to Offset Ad Valorem Tax with Northern Natural Gas Company which reduces the 2019 tax year as a result of the 2015-2016 tax year litigation, in the amount of \$141,306, as recommended by the Auditor/Treasurer.

On motion by Dahl and seconded by Hindt, the Board unanimously approved RESOLUTION 2020-019: Absentee Ballot Board for Primary and General Election, as recommended by the Auditor/Treasurer.

Jones updated the Board regarding the Presidential Nomination Primary Reimbursement submission, noting that \$49,623.87 was submitted for reimbursement from the Secretary of State.

The citizens input portion of the meeting was opened and closed at 9:30 a.m.

Andrew Hatzenbihler, Solid Waste Manager was present.

Hatzenbihler reviewed the proposed 8% rate increase for hauling fees by Harter's Quick Clean-up that he had presented at the April 28<sup>th</sup> meeting. He discussed four payment options of the requested increase from Harter's Quick Cleanup. The Solid Waste committee met and is recommending the added increase to be approved at 4% this year, followed by a 2% increase the next 2 years.

On motion by Dahl and seconded by Hindt, the Board unanimously approved the 4% increase for the first year, effective June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 and 2% for the following two years as of January 1<sup>st</sup> above the annual CPI increase, as recommended by the Solid Waste Administrator.

Kristina Kohn, Human Resources was present.

On motion by Bakke and seconded by Lentz, the Board unanimously approved hiring Donald Hanson as replacement Custodian at Grade 5/Step 1 at a rate of \$16.98/hour effective May 9, 2020 as requested by the Building Maintenance Supervisor and recommended by the Hiring Committee.

Bobbie Hillery, Administrator was present.

Hillery drafted a letter to Senator Miller and Representative Davids requesting extension of waivers and modifications for providing human services. Kevin Olson, Social Service Manager noted that other counties are sending similar letters to their legislators as well to encourage them to continue to allow the options that do not require a face to face meeting with their clients, noting that there are safety concerns for the clients and the employees.

On motion by Bakke and seconded by Dahl, the Board unanimously approved a Letter for Extending Waivers and Modifications to provide Human Services, as recommended by the Administrator.

Hillery presented a plan for the County to reopen after the Executive Orders are lifted. The Board approved the plan as presented.

On motion by Hindt and seconded by Bakke, the Board unanimously approved the purchase of glass and sneeze guards, not to exceed \$6,320, as recommended by the Administrator.

Hillery noted that they had received a request to allow access and right of way options for the former Preston Oil Company building located in Preston, MN which is a current forfeiture property. There has been a committee that has been working with the City of Preston to clean up this property. Attorney Corson gave a

summary of what stage the group is at with this clean up and noted that he is comfortable with the agreements as presented.

On motion by Bakke and seconded by Dahl, the Board unanimously approved the Site Access Agreement for MPCA to investigate underground storage tank release of forfeiture property.

On motion by Bakke and seconded by Lentz, the Board unanimously approved the Site Right Of Way Agreement for MPCA.

A review of the calendar was done with the following committee reports and announcements given: Bakke – Interviewed Consultants for Airport; Environment/Natural Resources conference call; Planning Commission will be via Webex next week Dahl – Airport Consultant Interviews; SEMCAC Lentz – SE EMS / Bluff County HRA Hindt – Solid Waste discussing the rate increase and Winneshiek Landfill Prestby – Solid Waste

It was the consensus of the Board to have Hillery send a thank you note to the Winona County Board for the assistance they provided by allowing the contractual agreement to share the Winona County Assessor Steve Hacken. Also, making note of the guidance that Steve Hacken gave Fillmore County and for his work finding us a full-time Assessor.

On motion by Hindt and seconded by Lentz, the Board chair adjourned at 10:31 a.m.

## Joint Powers Agreement National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) State of Minnesota

This Agreement is between the State of Minnesota, acting through its Commissioner of Public Safety on behalf of the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension [BCA] ("State"), and the County of Fillmore, acting on behalf of its Sheriff's Department ("Governmental Unit").

#### Recitals

- 1. Under Minnesota Statutes § 471.59, subdivision 10, the State is empowered to engage such assistance as deemed necessary. The BCA is the state agency that collects incident data and through which Minnesota crime statistics are reported to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). The FBI has established January 1, 2021, as the deadline by which all states must submit crime statistics in the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) format. The State is in need of assistance from the Governmental Unit to implement and certify the integration of incident reporting and the submission of crime statistics in the NIBRS format as well as crime statistics unique to Minnesota (MN-NIBRS).
- 2. Law enforcement agencies in the State of Minnesota are required to report crime statistics to the State. Subsequently the State reports those statistics to the FBI pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 299C.05. Current crime statistics reporting has less detail than is required to be MN-NIBRS compliant. The State has funding available to assist the Governmental Unit to implement and certify crime statistics reporting to meet MN-NIBRS requirements as well as submit incident data for use during investigations pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 299C.40.

### Agreement

#### 1 Term of Agreement

- **1.1 Effective Date.** The Agreement is effective on the date the State obtains all required signatures under Minnesota Statutes § 16C.05, subdivision 2.
- **1.2** Expiration Date. The Agreement ends April 30, 2021, or until all obligations have been satisfactorily fulfilled, whichever occurs first.
- **1.3 Deadlines for Compliance.** All terms of this Agreement between parties must be satisfactorily fulfilled by December 31, 2020, with the exception of Governmental Unit Duty 12, which has a deadline of April 30, 2021.

#### 2 Agreement Between the Parties

The Governmental Unit Duties:

- 1. Continue to submit its crime statistics until its submissions have been certified by State as MN-NIBRS compliant.
- 2. Coordinate and communicate with any other government agencies using Governmental Unit's records management system ("RMS") to do crime reporting to ensure that all understand the benefits of transitioning to NIBRS.
- 3. Draft and execute an agreement with its RMS vendor to implement an electronic submission format that will report its incident data in a format that meets BCA and MN-NIBRS reporting requirements. The Governmental Unit's agreement with its RMS vendor must provide that the vendor:
  - (a) guarantees the Governmental Unit is compliant with State's requirements as listed below in Items 10 and 11 below;
  - (b) is notified by the Governmental Unit of changes to the requirements listed below in Items 9 and 10;
  - (c) is provided by the Governmental Unit with documentation of the Crime Reporting System ("CRS");
  - (d) is required to assist in the resolution of any errors during the testing period and the corrective fixes be available to existing and future MN-NIBRS installations at no additional cost;
  - (e) provides the Governmental Unit with any documentation necessary for the successful operation of the input submissions.
- 4. Submit the agreement draft with its RMS vendor to the State for approval prior to execution.
- 5. Create a project plan with its RMS vendor identifying how the vendor will ensure that all the work required for the Governmental Unit to submit incident data and MN-NIBRS complaint crime statistics are within the scope of this Agreement.
- 6. Submit the project plan with its RMS vendor to the State for approval.
- 7. Refrain from authorizing work on the implementation of the MN-NIBRS compliant submissions until the State

approves the RMS vendor agreement draft, the agreement is executed, and the State approves the RMS vendor project plan.

- 8. Require the Governmental Unit's staff and the staff of the RMS vendor attend periodic status meetings and demonstrations organized by the State.
- 9. Assure the RMS vendor installs a version of software that is compliant with the State requirements.
- 10. Ensure that the implementation meets the requirements of the Minnesota Department of Public Safety's Security Architecture, State of Minnesota Non-Visual Access Standards (<u>https://mn.gov/mnit/assets/Stnd\_State\_Accessibility\_tcm38-61585.pdf</u>), and the CRS Vendor Adapter Specifications, and the CRS Data Mapping Requirements, which are posted on the CJIS Launch Pad (<u>https://bcanextest.x.state.mn.us/launchpad/</u>). These documents and any revisions posted to the website are incorporated into this Agreement by reference. The Governmental Unit is responsible for checking the website periodically for updates to these documents and providing any changes to its RMS vendor.
- 11. Test its electronic submissions in the State's test environment according to the "CRS Agency Vendor Test Plan" posted on the CJIS Launch Pad at <u>https://bcanextest.x.state.mn.us/launchpad/</u> located under MNJIS Training/ NIBRS. This document and any revisions posted to the website are incorporated into this Agreement by reference. The Governmental Unit is responsible for checking the website periodically for updates to these documents and providing any changes to its RMS vendor.
- 12. Achieve certification for its electronic submissions by sending three (3) consecutive months of MN-NIBRS compliant statistics with an error rate below 4% each month, a requirement of all government agencies reporting crime utilizing the RMS.
- **13.** Transition reporting MN-NIBRS compliant crime statistics in coordination with the State at a date and time specified by the State.

The State's Duties:

- 1. Accept Governmental Unit's crime statistics in the existing format in use on the effective date of this Agreement.
- 2. Provide the Governmental Unit with documents listed in Items 10 and 11 above and maintain their accuracy including any changes made by the State or FBI.
- 3. Review Governmental Unit's agreement draft with its RMS vendor for the required content and either approve or disapprove the agreement. - 4. Review Governmental Unit's project plan with its RMS vendor and either approve or disapprove the plan. If the plan is disapproved, the State will notify the Governmental Unit of the required changes to receive approval. State will review and act within ten (10) business days of receiving the plan from the Governmental Unit.
- 5. Schedule periodic status meetings and demonstrations as needed to ensure the project is completed.
- 6. Provide electronic schema and sample submission files that Governmental Unit can share with its RMS vendor.
- 7. Provide access to its test environment so that Governmental Unit can test its submissions.
- 8. Verify and validate Governmental Unit's submissions during the test period.
- **9.** Provide training to Governmental Unit on the submission requirements and best practices for MN-NIBRS compliance.
- **10.** Verify and validate Governmental Unit's submissions during the certification period including those made by government agencies using the RMS.
- 11. Issue written certification of MN-NIBRS compliance to Governmental Unit when the standards for submission have been met.
- **12.** Provide access to its production environment and authorize Governmental Unit to switch to MN-NIBRS reporting following the written certification.

#### 5 Assignment, Amendments, Waiver, and Agreement Complete

#### 7 State Audits

Under Minnesota Statutes § 16C.05, subdivision 5, the Governmental Unit's books, records, documents, and accounting procedures and practices relevant to this agreement are subject to examination by the State and/or the State Auditor or Legislative Auditor, as appropriate, for a minimum of six (6) years from the end of this Agreement.

#### 8 Government Data Practices

The Governmental Unit and State must comply with the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 13, as it applies to all data provided by the State under this agreement, and as it applies to all data created, collected, received, stored, used, maintained, or disseminated by the Governmental Unit under this agreement. The civil remedies of Minnesota Statutes § 13.08 apply to the release of the data referred to in this clause by either the Governmental Unit or the State.

#### 10 Termination

- **10.1 Termination.** The State or the Governmental Unit may terminate this agreement at any time, with or without cause, upon 30 days' written notice to the other party.
- **10.2 Termination for Insufficient Funding**. The State may immediately terminate this agreement if it does not obtain funding from the Minnesota Legislature, or other funding source; or if funding cannot be continued at a level sufficient to allow for the payment of the services covered here. Termination must be by written or fax notice to the Governmental Unit. The State is not obligated to pay for any services that are provided after notice and effective date of termination. However, the Governmental Unit will be entitled to payment, determined on a pro rata basis, for services satisfactorily performed to the extent that funds are available. The State will not be assessed any penalty if the agreement is terminated because of the decision of the Minnesota Legislature, or other funding source, not to appropriate funds. When people come to jail they get approved to be on STS by the courts at the discretion of Jail Administration. Once on STS, inmates can earn \$10 towards fines or pay to stay. No actually money exchanges hands, it is all done on paper. An example would be that an inmate has a \$500 fine so they complete 50 hours of STS to satisfy their fine. If their fines are satisfied the can work off CWS community work service hours. If everything is satisfied some inmates have the option to get day for day credit off their sentence. So, if they are sitting 60 days and do 20 days of STS they will only sit 40 days. If inmates do not have fines or CWS and are not able to earn day for day credit, they can still do STS for something to do.

Inmates on STS or less likely to get in trouble while in jail and less likely to be destructive or assaultive. Inmates on STS are less likely to require mental health and medical services.

County Inmates on STS are responsible for providing all their own clothes and equipment such as gloves, hats and boots.

The county STS inmates are also used in the jail for cleaning projects, dishes, snow removal and lawn care outside of work down with the crew leader.

ICWC Contract: July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2021 State is responsible for all inmate expenses including medical and clothing. The state pays the county \$57.50 per inmate per day. There is a 30 day termination in writing.

The county is responsible to pay ICWC wages. Level 1 60 days at \$1.00 per hour Level 2 30 days at \$1.00 per hour, 60 days at \$1.25 per hour Level 3 30 days at \$1.25 per hour, 90 days at \$1.50 per hour Level 4 Unlimited at \$1.50 per hour The state issues the ICWC pay check and the county reimburses the state.

ICWC inmates are used for projects outside of work with crew leader. They do projects with maintenance such as snow removal, repair to air conditioner at social services building, lawn care, tree care and leave pickup, painting at court house, painting stakes for high department, fleet car cleaning, furniture moving at court house and other.

## Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU")

## Between

## **Avenu Insights & Analytics**

## and

## Fillmore County, Minnesota

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the terms and understandings between Fillmore County, Minnesota ("County") and Avenu Insights & Analytics ("Avenu") to pursue their mutual interests to research, analyze, evaluate, design, develop and implement technology and analytically based solutions relating to Assessment and Appraisal in Fillmore County, MN in particular and the nation and worldwide property assessment and appraisal community in general.

### BACKGROUND

Avenu has and will continue to design, develop, market, sell and implement technological solutions and establish technology related initiatives designed to improve the administration of property taxes, assessment administration, and appraisal throughout the nation and worldwide.

The MnCCC and Fillmore County have in the past and have indicated their willingness to continue in the future to assist Avenu and be **a test bed of innovation** in order to achieve more effective and efficient operations regarding the administration of property taxes and property appraisal and thereby improve the lives of its community and constituents.

In addition, both Avenu and the County wish to **showcase the County** as vibrant, innovative and forwardthinking organizations with respect to analyzing, evaluating and implementing technologies, methods and technological models for use across the country and around the world.

### PURPOSE

The primary purpose of this MOU is to assist in the effective communication and coordination necessary to cooperatively work towards the design, development and implementation of technology solutions relating to the more effective and efficient administration of property assessment.

This MOU does not represent a commitment on behalf of either party to pursue specific initiatives, projects and/or results. Future initiatives, projects and/or results may require subsequent agreements between the parties.

A secondary purpose of this MOU is to enable the parties to define, promote and mutually pursue communications with other interested parties to in order to gather, share and expand knowledge within the nation and worldwide assessment and appraisal community. That is, both parties strive to showcase the results of the cooperative efforts carried out via this MOU with the assessment community at large.

### PROCESS

The PURPOSE of this MOU will be accomplished via the following PROCESS:

- 1. The County and Avenu will designate "LEAD" persons on behalf of their organizations re the MOU.
- 2. The County and Avenu will cooperate to schedule a "Kick-Off" meeting.
- 3. The County and Avenu will continually cooperate to schedule additional meetings, as deemed appropriate by both, in order to facilitate the exchange of information, ideas, results, etc.
- 4. The County will provide any/all technology related infrastructure required by any/all "proof of concept" ("POC") software that Avenu may, from time to time, at Avenus' sole discretion, provide the County. The County may, at their discretion, choose not to receive any/all such POC software.
- 5. If the County choose to accept POC software, the County will execute any necessary agreements relating to such software, e.g. a NDA, License Agreement, etc., prior to its receipt of said software.
- 6. The County and Avenu agree that certain aspects of this cooperative initiative may require confidentiality which is not merely, directly, related to the POC software. Therefore, both the County and Avenu agree to make every effort to cooperate in maintaining confidentiality re any/all confidentiality concerns expressed by the other.
- 7. The County assure Avenu that they intend to a good faith effort to eventually acquire the technology product(s) which Avenu develops and markets based on efforts relating to this MOU.
- 8. Avenu assures the County that it will license the POC software to the County as an enhancement to and replacement of the County's existing legacy software (i.e. Avenu's "CAMA USA" and related software) at no additional "licensing" cost to the County at such time as Avenu, in its sole discretion, deems the POC software to be in "general release" and therefore ready for use in a production environment providing that the County's Maintenance and Support contract has not lapsed and the term is active for a period of no less than five (5) years. In addition, Avenu will maintain the maintenance fee schedule, except for an annual escalation not to exceed to exceed the rate of five percent (5%), year -over-year, during the period of this agreement and the first five (5) years following the County's first production use of the POC Software.

## FUNDING

This MOU is not a commitment of funds to either party on behalf of the other party.

### DURATION

This MOU is "at-will" and may be modified by mutual consent of authorized officials from both parties or may be terminated by either party at any time. The MOU will terminate if the County Maintenance Agreement is terminated. This MOU shall become effective upon signature by the appropriate parties representing the County and Avenu.

#### NONDISCLOSURE AGREEMENT

THIS NONDISCLOSURE AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is dated \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ and is entered into by and between Avenu Insights and Analytics, LLC, a Delaware Company whose principal address is 5860 Trinity Parkway, Suite 120, Centreville, VA 20120 (the "Disclosing Party") and a whose

principal address is (the "Receiving Party"). Avenu and/or its subsidiaries or affiliates is willing to furnish the Receiving Party with certain information which is non-public, confidential or proprietary in nature. This information may be, without limitation, in whole or in part, whether furnished prior to, on or after the date hereof, oral, written, graphic, or electronic, and together with any analyses, compilations, studies or other documents prepared by the Receiving Party and its subsidiaries or affiliates' respective employees, officers, directors, contractors, agents, advisors (including without limitation, counsel, consultants and accountants) (collectively, "Representatives") that contain or otherwise reflect such information is hereinafter referred to as the "Confidential Information." In consideration of the Disclosing Party furnishing the Confidential Information, agrees that:

1. <u>Confidentiality</u>. The Receiving Party will exercise due diligence to maintain the strict confidentiality of all Confidential Information furnished to it or learned by it hereunder and will use the Confidential Information solely in connection with the purposes agreed upon between us. "Due diligence" shall mean at least the same precautions and standard of care which a reasonable person in such business would use to safeguard proprietary information of its own and its other clients.

2. <u>Restriction in Use; No License.</u> The Receiving Party agrees that the Confidential Information provided by or on behalf of the Disclosing Party shall at all times remain the exclusive property of the Disclosing Party and the Receiving Party will not use or disclose Confidential Information to anyone (other than its Representatives) without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent. No license to use any of the Disclosing Party's Confidential Information or intellectual property is granted by this Agreement, except as may be specifically required for the purpose of this Agreement, and then only for such purpose.

3. <u>Reverse Engineering</u>. The Receiving Party agrees not to, and not to attempt to (and will not permit its Representatives to), reverse engineer or decompile any software, hardware, firmware or other technology programs provided to it by or on behalf of the Disclosing Party under this Agreement, unless it has obtained the Disclosing Party's prior written consent.

4. Access; Return. The Receiving Party agrees to permit access to the Confidential Information only to its Representatives who need to know the Confidential Information for the purposes set forth herein and who shall be subject to a confidentiality or professional obligation, duty or agreement, code of conduct or confidentiality undertaking that is at least as restrictive as the provisions of this Agreement from a confidentiality perspective. Should the Receiving Party have reason to believe that any Confidential Information has been disclosed to a person not authorized to receive such information, the Receiving Party shall inform the Disclosing Party in writing as promptly as practicable. Under such circumstances, the Receiving Party shall use commercially reasonable efforts to limit any damage that may be caused to the Disclosing Party as a result of the disclosure. The Receiving Party also agrees to promptly notify the Disclosing Party of any breach by it or its Representatives of this Agreement of which the Receiving Party becomes aware, and in any event, the Receiving Party shall be responsible for any breach of this Agreement by any of its Representatives. Upon the Disclosing Party's written request, except as may be required for archival or compliance purposes, and except for the portion of the Confidential Information that consists of analyses, compilations, studies or other documents prepared by the Receiving Party or its Representatives, the Receiving Party agrees to return promptly the Confidential Information and any copies or extracts thereof. The Receiving Party shall destroy that portion of the Confidential Information which consists of analyses, compilations, studies or other documents prepared by it or its Representatives to the extent permitted by applicable law or regulation and except as may be required for archival or compliance purposes. If requested by the Disclosing Party, such destruction shall be certified in writing to it by one of the Receiving Party's authorized officers. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement to the contrary, each party agrees to promptly inform the other party if it believes that it erroneously or unintentionally disclosed Confidential Information to the other party, and in any such instance, the Receiving Party will dispose of such Confidential Information as instructed by the Disclosing Party.

5. <u>Scope</u>. Confidential Information for purposes of this Agreement also includes any metadata, source code, object code, firmware or other data or information embedded in, or attached to, electronic documents or other media provided by the Disclosing Party or on behalf of the Disclosing Party. However, the term Confidential Information does not include information that (a) is or becomes generally available to the public other than as a result of, direct or indirect, disclosure in breach of this Agreement by the Receiving Party or any of its Representatives; (b) is or becomes available to the Receiving

Party on a non-confidential basis from a source other than the Disclosing Party who is not known by the Receiving Party to be bound by a confidentiality agreement with the Disclosing Party or other legal or fiduciary obligation of secrecy to, or for the benefit of, the Disclosing Party; (c) the Receiving Party can document was known to it or in its possession on a nonconfidential basis prior to the date of disclosure by the Disclosing Party; (d) was or is independently developed by the Receiving Party or any of its Representatives without use of, or reference to, the Confidential Information, as demonstrated by tangible evidence; or (e) is furnished by the Disclosing Party to others with written confirmation that such information is not confidential and may be disclosed.

6. Disclosure Legally Compelled. In the event that the Receiving Party or any of its Representatives becomes legally compelled (or requested by an applicable regulatory body) to disclose any of the Confidential Information, the Receiving Party will provide the Disclosing Party with prompt written notice, unless providing such notice would violate applicable law or regulation, so that the Disclosing Party may seek a protective order or other appropriate remedy (and if the Disclosing Party seeks such an order, the Receiving Party will provide such cooperation as the Disclosing Party reasonably requests) and/or waive compliance with the provisions of this Agreement. In the event that such a protective order or other remedy is not obtained, or if the Disclosing Party waives compliance with the provisions of this Agreement, the Receiving Party (or its Representatives, as applicable) will furnish only that portion of the Confidential Information which is legally required (based on the advice of its internal or external counsel).

7. Additional Restrictions on Disclosure and Contacts. Except as required by the rules and regulations of the Securities and Exchange Commission or any applicable stock exchange, securities commission or regulatory agency or authority (in which case the Receiving Party and its Representatives will use reasonable efforts to notify the Disclosing Party before complying with such rules and regulations), each party agrees not to, and will direct its Representatives not to, disclose to any third party (a) the existence or contents of this Agreement, (b) the fact that it is evaluating the Confidential Information or the possibility of a transaction with the other party or (c) any term, condition or other fact relating to discussions or negotiations between the parties to this Agreement in relation to the Confidential Information, unless it has received the prior written consent of the other party. Each party acknowledges that direct contact with any employees, sales representatives, suppliers, customers, competitors or others involved with the other party (other than contacts in the ordinary course of business) could seriously impair our respective businesses, and each party agrees to refrain from any and all such contact unless first obtaining approval from the other party.

8. <u>Specific Performance</u>. Each party acknowledges and agrees that, in the event of any breach of this Agreement by a party or its Representatives, the non-breaching party may be

irreparably and immediately harmed and might not be made whole by monetary damages. Without prejudice to any rights and remedies otherwise available, the non-breaching party may be entitled to equitable relief by way of injunction, specific performance or otherwise if the breaching party or any of its Representatives breach any provision of this Agreement.

9. <u>Competitive Development</u>. Each party recognizes that the other (including certain of its affiliates) may be engaged in the research, development, production, marketing, licensing and/or sale of similar services or products to those being considered under this Agreement. These services or products may be competitive with those of the other and may display the same or similar functionality. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to prevent either of us from engaging independently in such activities, provided it does not use the Confidential Information of the other in order to do so.

10. No Representations. NEITHER PARTY NOR ANY OF ITS RESPECTIVE DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, ADVISORS OR REPRESENTATIVES HAVE MADE OR MAKE ANY EXPRESS OR IMPLIED REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY HEREUNDER AS TO THE ACCURACY OR COMPLETENESS OF THE CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION AND NONE OF THEM SHALL HAVE ANY LIABILITY HEREUNDER TO THE OTHER PARTY OR ANY OF ITS REPRESENTATIVES OR ANY OTHER PERSON RELATING TO OR RESULTING FROM USE OF THE CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION OR FOR ANY ERRORS THEREIN OR OMISSIONS THEREFROM. Each party also agrees that the other party is not entitled to rely on the completeness or accuracy of any Confidential Information. Each party expressly disclaims any and all liability for Confidential Information transmitted orally or in writing to the other party or its Representatives excepting only those particular representations and warranties which, in fact, are made in a definitive agreement, signed by the parties on or after the date of this Agreement, and subject to such limitations and restrictions as may be contained therein.

11. <u>No Contract.</u> This Agreement does not give rise to any intention, commitment or obligation of either party to buy or sell or to enter into any kind of business relationship with the other party.

12. <u>Export Control Laws</u>. Subject to the conditions of this Agreement, each party agrees not to export, directly or indirectly, any Confidential Information acquired pursuant to this Agreement or any product using any such Confidential Information, except in accordance with applicable export control laws, rules and regulations.

13. <u>Choice of Law.</u> This Agreement will be governed by and construed under, the laws of the State of Minnesota, without regard to the principles of choice of law. This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of the parties and their respective successor and assigns.

14. Entire Agreement/Assignment; Term. This Agreement represents the entire understanding and agreement of the parties and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings relating to the subject matter hereof. This Agreement may not be modified or amended, except by a written instrument duly executed by both parties. Neither of us may assign this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other party (which shall not be unreasonably withheld or delayed); provided, however, that Avenu may assign this Agreement to an affiliate or to a third party successor-in-interest to all or substantially all of its business, assets or stock without such consent. Confidential Information disclosed pursuant to this Agreement shall be subject to the terms of this Agreement for three (3) years following the initial date of disclosure (which may be prior to the date of execution of this Agreement), except that Confidential Information that constitutes trade secrets of the Disclosing Party shall be subject to the terms of this Agreement for as long as such information remains a trade secret under applicable law and Confidential Information that constitutes personally identifiable information shall be subject to the terms of this Agreement forever, without expiration,

15. Severability. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this Agreement shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the other provisions of this Agreement, which shall remain in full force and effect. If any of the provisions of this Agreement shall be deemed to be unenforceable by reason of its extent, duration, scope or otherwise, then the parties contemplate that the court making such determination shall enforce the remaining provisions of this Agreement, and shall reduce such extent, duration, scope, or other provision and shall enforce them in their reduced form for all purposes contemplated by this Agreement.

According to Minnesota Statutes 273.01, I am required to physically inspect 20% of properties annually to maintain compliance with state law and recently received guidance from the Minnesota Department of Revenue that despite the concerns with COVID-19, this obligation must still be fulfilled.

The Fillmore County Assessor's Office has formulated a plan to address our statutorily defined obligations while still recognizing precautionary measures to ensure this process can be completed as safely as possible. With your cooperation, here is how we are planning to address our inspection requirements for the 2021 Assessment:

- 1. We will only perform exterior inspections of the properties due for review. We will not approach the door and will not leave a tag.
- 2. Our inspection will be completed with as minimal contact on the property as possible. In most situations we will restrict ourselves to only the bare essentials required to adequately perform the functions of this task. What you can expect:
  - a. We will be taking a picture of your property to reference when completing maintenance for our files.
  - b. We will be attempting to confirm as many measurements as possible with our GIS software. This has been tested and found to be accurate. Unfortunately, in areas with significant tree cover, this may force us to confirm information while on the property. We will first review the data already maintained in our records and gauge the necessity of physically confirming the measurement while at your property and only pursue this action if deemed absolutely necessary.

Due to the COVID-19 threat, we are not going to be able to confirm as much information as we would typically consider acceptable to complete the appraisal of your property. We are requesting you to contact the office at 507-765-3868 to review interior information.

We appreciate your cooperation with this process and look forward to speaking with you. If you have additional questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to contact me.

#### Fillmore County Assessor's Office 2021 Assessment Quintile Policy

The Minnesota Department of Revenue provided guidance on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 regarding the 2021 Assessment and Quintile work required by Minnesota Statutes 273.08 and 273.01. The nature of the guidance was to address Quintile compliance while ensuring the safety of the public and county staff during the COVID-19 pandemic.

In order to ensure compliance with Minnesota Statutes and recognize safety issues that may be experienced by county staff and the public while completing this obligation, the following policy was developed to provide direction and guidance.

Below are a list of policies and procedures staff are expected to follow while completing their 2021 Assessment Quintile work:

- 1. The Fillmore County Assessor's Office will utilize all means necessary to complete our statutorily defined obligations for compliance with Minnesota Statutes 273.01 and 273.08.
  - a. Alternative Methods of Data Collection with taxpayers:
    - i. Some counties have experienced success sending a post card to each property owner requesting appointments. This practice will be employed to request taxpayers to follow up with information regarding their property, mitigating interpersonal communication.
    - ii. Email
    - iii. Telephone
  - b. Utilize alternative resources to collect information and verify measurements:
    - i. Aerial Photography
    - ii. Pictometry
    - iii. Street Level Images (Google Maps provides and economical source of information)
    - iv. Zillow, Redfin, MLS, and other property sales/management sites providing property information.\*

\*Any information acquired from third party sources needs to be verified for accuracy

- 2. A priority will be placed on bare land assessments which involve little to no contact with the public. Appraisers will focus efforts ensuring land classifications are accurate using the resources defined above and then confirm with a physical inspection of the parcel.
- 3. Improved parcel inspections will be limited to external inspections only with any taxpayer contact regarding those inspections being completed through phone.
  - a. Letters will be sent to parcels requiring an inspection. The letter will provide direction for the taxpayer and outline our procedure for the inspection under the current circumstances.
  - b. Any properties in which the appraiser feels an interior inspection should be completed will be flagged for further review later in the year.
- 4. Staff will take necessary precautions while performing physical inspections. This includes, but is not limited to, the utilization of facemasks, gloves, and any other means deemed necessary to avoid the spread of the COVID-19 virus.
- 5. Any New Construction inspections will be completed later in the year.

- a. As the majority of new construction inspections require tours of property, consultations with the property owner, and physically measuring the improvement, these tasks should be delayed until the threat of the COVID-19 virus subsides.
- 6. Outside of training opportunities, the staff will perform field inspections individually.
  - a. During training opportunities the staff will select jurisdictions in close proximity to the office. Every effort will be made to maintain social distancing while working in pairs.
  - b. If deemed necessary, separate vehicles will be utilized to transport staff to and from quintile area.
  - c. All relevant precautions should be addressed to avoid transmission of the COVID-19 virus
    - i. No sharing of appraisal equipment
    - ii. Define roles during the inspection to maintain consistency in the utilization of resources
- 7. Any activities not specifically defined by this policy should be addressed following CDC guidelines to mitigate the potential spread of the COVID-19 virus.
