Services

Supportive Housing

- Emergency shelter, transitional housing and permanent apartments
- Safe Harbor- Long term housing for youth ages 16-24 who have been sexually exploited or trafficked

24 Hour Crisis Line

- Staffed 24-hours a day, 7-days a week by trained domestic abuse advocates
- Counseling and referrals

Community Advocacy Services

- Individual support
- Assistance with safety planning
- Housing options
- Transportation
- Assistance with criminal and civil court issues

Community Outreach

We provide speakers to groups looking to learn more about our organization, our services, or domestic violence in general. All training is free of charge.

Resource Center

Our resource center is free and open to women in our community and offers legal advocacy, support groups, access to computers/printers/copy machine, and resources.

Support and Info Groups

- Weekly support and information groups give women the chance to talk about their experiences with a trained advocate.
- Topics range from types of abuse and manipulation, to finding housing and personal growth.
- Childcare is available while attending group.
