

5) Prior to the setting of the county monument, the private land surveyor shall furnish corner location evidence and calculations to the County Land Surveyor for review and approval.

6) A standard county monument or a monument approved by the County Surveyor and three reference ties shall be set prior to payment where a new monument is needed. The tie shall show bearing and distance to the nearest hundredth of a foot.

7) Three reference ties shall be set prior to payment where a durable monument already exists that does not need to be replaced with a county monument. The tie shall show bearing and distance to the nearest hundredth of a foot.

8) That, whenever reasonably possible, the private land surveyor shall provide a digital picture to the County Surveyor of the accepted found monument and/or the set county monument at the section or quarter section corner location. Also, if a backhoe is used to excavate for the corner a digital picture shall be provided to the County Surveyor showing evidence of the excavation.

9) Any original or perpetuated evidence found during the course of a survey of the section or quarter section corners, such as bearing tree blaze or scribe, stones, wood post, irons, etc., shall belong to Fillmore County and/or the Fillmore County Historical Society.

10) That wherever reasonably possible the Land Surveyor shall reference his or her Land Survey and Corner Certificate to the HARN 1996, NAD83 Fillmore County Coordinate System in feet.

11) No "Certificate of Location of Government Corner" shall be recorded in Fillmore County without the acceptance and approval of the Fillmore County Surveyor.

12) The "Certificate of Location of Government Corner" must be recorded at the Fillmore County Recorder's Office prior to payment.

13) A written request for payment shall be received, accepted and approved by the Fillmore County Surveyor.

14) Request for payment must be made, not more than (6) calendar months, after the location of each corner and placement of monument.


