Mayor Alexander called the Special Meeting to order at 5:32 p.m. after declaring a quorum present.

Council Member Warnock led the Pledge of Allegiance & Pledge to the Texas Flag.

FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS:

1. 2nd Public Hearing on the Proposed 2018-2019 City of Fort Stockton Budget & Tax Rate of \$0.4533 Per \$100 Valuation of Taxable Property.

Mayor Alexander asked for comments from the public. Being that there were not any comments from the public ---

Director of Finance Rodriguez reported that revisions to the Proposed Budget from the 1st Public Hearing included:

City Council:

- The "Public Safety Building" line item was decreased from \$350,000 to \$250,000 to accommodate for "no entries" to utilities; &
- "Contingency" being the balance/offset line increased to \$115,505 from \$110,165.


Economic Development Corporation 4A Fund:

The Board authorized the EDC Director to purchase a vehicle. Additional funds were not added to this department's proposed budget. Revisions included:

- "Loan & Business Exploration" decreased from \$247,890 to \$201,090;
- "Car Allowance" decreased from \$3,000 to \$0.
- A "Vehicle" line was added for \$46,800;
- A "Fuel Supplies" line was added for \$2,000;
- A "Maintenance of Vehicle" line was added for \$1,000.

There being no further business, the Special City Council Meeting was adjourned @ 5:37 p.m.
