

ORDINANCE NO. 18-128

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF FORT STOCKTON, TEXAS, PERSONNEL POLICIES MANUAL BY RECLASSIFYING THE "CRIME SCENE UNIT TECH/INVENTORY TECH; PAY GRADE 22" POSITION TO THE "CRIME SCENE UNIT TECH/INVENTORY TECH; PAY GRADE 11" POSITION & INCORPORATING THE LATTER POSITION & JOB DESCRIPTION INTO THE APPROPRIATE SECTION OF THE JOB CLASSIFICATION TABLE & COMPENSATION PLAN AND FURTHERMORE ELIMINATING THE FORMER POSITION; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; & PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the proposed reconstruction in the City of Fort Stockton Personnel Regulations, as shown in the attached "Exhibit A" reflect the restructuring of City Administration to the Personnel Policies which provides greater flexibility in the management of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT STOCKTON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City of Fort Stockton Job Classification Table & Compensation Plan is hereby amended & Reclassifies the Crime Scene Unit Tech/Inventory Tech; Pay Grade 22" Position to the "Crime Scene Unit Tech/Inventory Tech; Pay Grade 11" Position to the City of Fort Stockton Personnel Policies and Regulations.

SECTION 2: If any provisions, section, exception, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances, shall for any reason be held unconstitutional, void or invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance or their application to other persons or sets of circumstances and to this end all provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed; provided however, that such repeal shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other respects this ordinance shall be cumulative of other ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this ordinance.


SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective after its approval and adoption upon final reading and its publication pursuant to law.


