OFFICIAL MINUTES

The Board of Fremont County Commissioners met in Special Session at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Chairman Travis Becker, Vice-Chairman Larry Allen, Clarence Thomas, Jennifer McCarty and Mike Jones. County Clerk Julie Freese was present via Zoom and Deputy County Clerk Margy Irvine was present.

Clarence Thomas moved, Larry Allen seconded, to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried unanimously.

There were 12 people present in the audience (a list is available in the Commissioners' Office) and ten people attended via Zoom.

Larry Allen moved, Clarence Thomas seconded, to ratify approval of amended State grant awards for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant applicants Big Brothers Big Sisters from \$24,225 to \$18,400 and Boys and Girls Club from \$11,000 to \$8,350. Motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Becker stated the main purpose of the Special Meeting to review the proposal from Priority Ambulance which had been received Friday morning, and after publication of the Agenda, a second proposal was received from AMR, which would also be reviewed today. He further stated that following the meeting, both Proposals would be available on the County website.

Chairman Travis Becker noted both proposals contain a lot of information to be reviewed; however, for today the main topic would be the subsidy listed in each one:

AMR (4 ALS ambulances)	Year 1: \$1,208,000	Year 2: \$1,915,000
Priority Ambulance (5 ALS ambulances)	\$903,538	

Mike Jones moved, Jennifer McCarty seconded, to move forward with negotiations with Priority Ambulance Services with Chairman Becker and Vice-Chairman Allen consisting of the working group for the Commission. Motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, Mike Jones moved, Jennifer McCarty seconded, to adjourn the meeting at 9:35 a.m. and reconvene for a Regular Meeting on June 1, 2021. Motion carried unanimously.
