## ORDINANCE #850

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE TOWN OF HUDSON, WYOMING AND FURTHER RELATING TO FIXING AND DETERMINING THE AMOUNTS OF GENERAL TAX TO BE LEVIED TO MEET THE CURRENT EXPENSES OF SAID TOWN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON THE 1<sup>ST</sup> DAY OF JULY 2020 AND ENDING AT MIDNIGHT ON THE 30<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF JUNE 2021, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1. The following sums of money for the objects and purposes herein specified which are deemed necessary to defray expenses and liability for the Town of Hudson, for the period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.


Section 2. Provided further that a general tax levy of eight mills be made on all taxable property within the Town of Hudson.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


