NOTICE TO OPERATOR

« EQUIPMENT REQUIRED FOR OPERATION »

Multipurpose vehicles operated on streets, roads, or highways in the State of Wyoming are required to be equipped with specific equipment pursuant to Title 31, Chapter 5, of Wyoming Statutes. All equipment shall be operational and meet statutory requirements. Operation of an MPV on Interstate Highways is prohibited.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OPERATOR TO ENSURE THE MPV HAS THE FOLLOWING EQUIPMENT:

Multipurpose Vehicle Greater than 50 inches wide Multipurpose Vehicle 50 inches or less in width Two headlights, one on each side One headlight Two tail lamps, one on each side One tail lamp ► Two rear reflectors One rear reflector Two stop lamps One stop lamp ► Muffler(s) Muffler(s) ► ► Brakes Brakes ► Mirror(s) Mirror(s) ► Horn Horn

• If a multipurpose vehicle is incapable of achieving the maximum speed allowed on the specific highway, it shall be operated on the extreme right hand edge of the roadway and shall be equipped with either a reflectorized flag as described in W. S. 31-5-960 (a)(vi) or a slow moving vehicle emblem as described in W. S. 31-5-921 (h);

► Multipurpose vehicles designed for operation at speeds less than twenty-five (25) miles per hour SHALL be equipped with a slow moving vehicle emblem as described in W. S. 31-5-921 (h).

► A valid drivers' license and insurance are required to operate multipurpose vehicles on streets, roads, or highways.
