Working under the State Health Officer, and Fremont County Board of County Commissioners, the County Health Officer aids in ensuring the overall health of the county. The County Health Officer is contracted by the Wyoming Department of Health for participation in the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program. The county health officer is available to participate in Fremont County public health's emergency response exercises and actual events. The county health officer serves as a resource to Fremont County public health and provides medical consultation aimed at informing and educating county residents regarding health issues. Must be a physician from an accredited school of medicine.

- Strong interest or experience in the public health field.
- Licensed to practice medicine in the State of Wyoming.
- Resident of Fremont County, Wyoming
- Training or completion of training in the Incident Command System (ICS) courses as part of the National Incident Management System
