CITY OF GLADWIN **YARD WASTE GUIDELINES**

The DPW will pick up yard waste on the second and fourth Wednesday during the months of May, September, and October. Yard waste is picked up on the fourth Wednesday in April, June, July, and August. Yard waste pickup scheduled for November is tentative and will depend on the weather. All acceptable yard waste (leaves, grass clippings, weeds, & garden debris) must be contained in compostable paper bags. Unacceptable items include branches, limbs, stumps, root-balls, dirt, rocks, and landscaping timbers. Yard waste will not be accepted in plastic bags, grocery bags, cardboard boxes, or other unapproved containers.

The DPW will chip brush for residential properties only during the last full work week during the months of April through October. Brush chipping scheduled for November is tentative and will depend on the weather. The City does not chip for lot clearing. Branches and limbs must not exceed 3" in diameter. Brush should be placed with cut ends facing the street in small bundles (no more than an armful). Have brush out for pickup before the first scheduled day of chipping (see schedule).
