

VOTING METHOD

To pass, any motion must receive five affirmative votes--that is, approval by a majority of all Board members. The chairman has full voice and vote on all motions put before the Board and may introduce motions.

Votes shall be taken by voice or show of hands. Upon request of any member, the vote shall be by roll call or written ballot, with all Board members participating in the meeting.

The outcome of all votes shall be recorded in the minutes.
