

IMMUNIZATION OF STUDENTS

Immunization is mandatory for all students, kindergarten through grade twelve (K-12). Exact regulations are issued from the Wyoming State Department of Health. According to Wyoming School Immunization Law - W.S. 21-4-309 every child in the school district, including children entering school for the first time, must have a record verifying required immunizations. Students not meeting this regulation will be enrolled only under the condition that appropriate immunization will be received within thirty (30) days.
