LET IT SNOW!


I am well aware that many of you would prefer to never see this white magic, but we live in Michigan, so let's talk reality; snow is coming!!!!

The DDA pays for all areas highlighted in yellow to be plowed with every snowfall. Individual business owners pay for any areas highlighted in green. Any sidewalks or entryways not highlighted are the responsibility of the business owners.

HEADS UP...

Michigan's Open & Obvious Doctrine has been abolished. What does this mean to you?

In the past, if a hazard on your property was open and obvious, you would have had no need to warn the plaintiff because it was assummed the plaintiff should be able to notice and avoid it.

On July 28, 2023, however, the MI Supreme Court abolished this doctrine, stating that if a hazard is open and obvious the landowner should notice it, anticipate any potential danger and take actions to remove/repair said danger.

What Can You Do to Protect Yourself?

- 1.Be pro-active in identifying potential hazards. Notify customers of them and repair/remedy them as quickly as possible.
- 2. Keep maintenance logs of snow/ice removal as well as dates/times of any salting you do.
- 3. Should an incident occur, complete a detailed report including pictures of the area.
