What year did Tippy Cow open? May of 2014 so we are now in our 10th season. Why an ice cream shop? This has always been my dream. I grew up working at an ice cream shop in my hometown of Plymouth, MI, Dairy-Go-Round and just always dreamed of having my own. I'm so thankful to live out my dream and I mean who doesn't love ice cream.

How many original flavors? We rotate around 25 original flavors at any given time but are up to about 50 flavors that we rotate through and are constantly growing. We try hard to also make sure we have options for people who cannot or choose not to eat gluten or dairy.

What is your favorite flavor? My favorite is probably Salted Oreo or Cake Batter right now but I'm constantly enjoying the new ones and really loved our new Strawberry Rhubarb Crisp.

What are you most proud of regarding the shop? I'm proud of the girls that work for me and how I've been able to hopefully be a great part of their young-adult lives. I always say those years that most of them are working for me (14-22) are some of the hardest just figuring out life, and I hope I can be a good influence and good support for them.

What would you say is the key to your success? I think that dedication, an amazing staff, a very supportive husband, and just love of the shop is key to my success. It takes a lot to run a business and even more to run a business well. Being surrounded by good people makes all the difference.

What do you LOVE about Grandville? I love the community and the customers. So many of them have become friends and I have loved getting to watch so many of the kids grow up over the years (and then to get to employ some of them! :)) Getting to be a part of the local events and also getting to collab with other area businesses this year has been so fun.
