Utah is experiencing one of the worst droughts on record. We don't know how long it will last, so we all need to reduce our use. Here are some tips we can follow to "Slow the Flow".

- Water only 2x a week. It's best before 10:00 am.
- Raise your mower.
- Prioritize your watering. Water trees and shrubs first.
- Don't water when it's windy because wind increases evaporation.
- Earn a rebate: Discover what rebates you can get at utahwatersavers.com.
- Listen to your local water providers (Grantsville Irrigation and Grantsville City) for possible watering restrictions.
