

## **GRANTSVILLE CITY NOTICE OF ELECTION AND FILING PERIOD**

Grantsville City will hold a municipal election to elect three (3) Councilmembers for a four-year term. Given a sufficient number of candidates, a Primary Election will be held on August 15, 2023, with the Municipal General Election being held on November 7, 2023.

Qualifications for a candidate are:

- Be a United States citizen;
- Be at least 18 years old;
- Be a resident of the municipality or a resident of recently annexed area for at least 365 consecutive days immediately preceding the date of the election;
- Be a registered voter of the municipality.

In accordance with Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored pursuant to Utah Code §20A-2-101.5

Qualified candidates may file a Declaration of Candidacy form or a Petition may be filed on behalf of a qualified person. The filing is to be done in person with the City Recorder unless individuals have designated an agent pursuant to Utah Code §20A-9-203(3)(b). The filing period is from **June 1, 2023 to June 7, 2023, Monday – Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm**. Pursuant to state law the deadline for filing is **5:00 pm on June 7<sup>th</sup>**.

All candidates for election are subject to financial disclosure requirements.
