**Reminder:** With summer arriving, more people are going to be out in their OHVs. Please remember to obey traffic laws and be safe. According to Grantsville City Ordinance 17-4-4 no one under the age of 12 can operate an OHV and anyone between the ages of 12-16 must be accompanied by an adult. Beginning January 1, 2023, Utah requires all OHV operators to complete the free Utah Off-Highway Vehicle Education Course. Operators under the age of 18 shall possess a youth OHV education certificate in order to operate an OHV on public land, road or trail. Operators 18 years of age or older may operate an OHV if they possess an approved adult OHV education certificate. The once-in-a-lifetime course is expected to take less than 30 minutes to complete.

**Rocky Mountain Power:** RMP is preparing to do upgrade work on the transmission line to Grantsville and will need to do some preliminary work at the Grantsville Substation starting the 3rd week of June & all of July.
