Please visit the city website under the city council tab for specific details. Comment via email by 6:00 p.m. on June 3rd. Message from Marilyn K. Gillette, Tooele County Clerk about Primary Election: "Ballots for the upcoming Primary Election will be coming to your mailbox the 2nd week in June. I can't express how important it is that you vote the ballot that you receive. Please vote it as soon as possible. Once the ballot gets to us, it has to sit for 3 days before we can process it, due to COVID-19.

- Last day to register is June 19th.
- There will be NO in-person polling locations in Grantsville.
- On Election Day, June 30th, there will be a mobile polling location at the County Building. This will only be for the disabled, if you did not receive a ballot, and for emergencies only.
- There is only one ballot available for Grantsville residents, the Republican Party ballot.
- If you are a registered Republican, a ballot will be mailed to you.
- Unaffiliated voters who want to vote the Republican Ballot, will have to affiliate with the party by June 19th.
