The Grantsville City Council will hold a Public Hearing on June 2nd, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall. The hearing is for the 2021-2022 fiscal year budget and proposed year end budget adjustments. REMINDERS

Grantsville City will hold a municipal election to elect two (2) city council members for a four-year term; and one (1) Mayor for a four-year term. Qualified candidates may file their Declaration of Candidacy in person with the City Recorder. The filing period is from June 1, 2021 to June 7, 2021, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Pursuant to the State Code, the deadline for filing is 5:00 p.m. on June 7th. Reminder: If residents decide to hook into culinary water for outdoor use, a cross connection inspection is **required** to make sure there is a back flow preventer. Please call 435-884-4671 to make an appointment for a free, but mandatory, inspection.

A back flow preventer is essential to keep our city water clean and not contaminated. **Culinary and Irrigation water cannot be connected to a sprinkling system at the same time.** Any resident contaminating city water will be held responsible for the costly procedure to disinfect the water.

Please be courteous and respectful when attending the events. Some prefer masks and others don't. Please social distance whenever possible.
