## REMINDERS

Dog Licenses are due on March 31st. Cost is \$15 for a spayed or neutered dog or \$25 if they are not. A clinic sponsored by the Grantsville Police Dept. and the Grantsville FFA program will be March 26th from 5:00pm until 7:00pm at the Grantsville Fire Station (26th North Center). Rabies shots will be available from Dr. Gowans (cash or check only). A current rabies shot is a requirement for licensing your dog.



We would like to remind our residents of the city code that does not allow private improvements to streets and sidewalks. This is to protect the infrastructure of the city. Please refer to city code 17-1-6 Private Improvements To Streets And Sidewalks to review the entire code.

It shall be unlawful for any person to make any improvements, changes or obstructions to city streets, rights-of-way, or sidewalks without first making application to and receiving written approval from the city. Any person who has made changes to city streets, sidewalks without approval, shall immediately restore the street, or sidewalk to its original condition.
