Information on the June Primary Election. As with everything else, the June Primary is an event in motion. Below are changes passed by the Legislature in their special session.

*There will be no Early Voting for this election. There will be no In-person polling locations.

*On Election Day only, there will be a mobile polling location – by appointment only – at the County Building for the disabled, and emergencies only.

*We do not know which political parties will have elections yet.

*Unaffiliated voters who want to vote in this election will have to affiliate or designate a party ballot 11 days before the election, as there will be no affiliating or requesting on election day. *It's time for Spring Cleaning! The City is offering an extra bulk pick-up day for residents. This is a great opportunity to beautify our city. Please follow the rules for bulk pick-up or it will not be taken. You can find the rules for bulk pick up on our website www.grantsvilleut.gov. You do not need to schedule pickup.

- If your regular garbage pick-up day is Monday or Tuesday, there will be bulk pick-up for your home on **Monday**, May 4th **AND Monday**, May 11th.
- If your regular garbage pick-up day is Wednesday or Thursday, there will be bulk pick-up for your home on **Monday**, May 18th **AND Tuesday**, May 26th.

East Durfee Street (from Willow to Worthington) and North Hale Street will be repaved. Weather permitting, work will begin the second week of May. Please use alternate routes while roads are under construction.
