The Grantsville City Council will hold a Public Hearing on May 5th, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall on the City's proposed 2021-2022 tentative fiscal year budget of Grantsville City. Residents may attend in person but please wear a face covering.

UDOT has informed us that they will begin two pavement renewal projects near Grantsville City. The 1st project is on S.R. 138 between Grantsville and S.R. 36. The 2nd project is S.R. 112 between Grantsville & Tooele. Residents are encouraged to plan ahead and use alternate routes during construction. Project 1 is expected to begin in early May and Project 2 is expected to begin early July. Work is expected to last through the summer. Grantsville City will hold a municipal election to elect two (2) city council members for a four-year term; and one (1) Mayor for a four-year term. Qualified candidates may file their Declaration of Candidacy in person with the City Recorder. The filing period is from June 1, 2021 to June 7, 2021, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Pursuant to the State Code, the deadline for filing is 5:00 p.m. on June 7th. *It's time for Spring Cleaning! The City is offering dumpsters around the City for residents to use to clean up their yards. This is a great opportunity to beautify our city. Please abide by the following rules so we can continue offering these opportunities.

- Do not put appliances with freon in the dumpsters. Tires, batteries, oil and hazardous waste are also not accepted. These dumpsters are not for regular household garbage.
- Do not put garbage outside of the dumpster. If it is full, wait for it to be emptied before you add to it. Garbage cannot be left after the dumpster is gone.

Dumpsters will be at the following locations and dates:

For residents who live west of Willow Street, there will be a dumpster at the Hollywood Park AND one at the parking lot near the cemetery on Saturday, May 8th from 7:00 am until 2:00 pm.

For residents who live east of Willow Street, there will be a dumpster at the corner of North Bowery and Clark Street AND one at the south end of Worthington Street on Saturday, May 22nd from 7:00 am until 2:00 pm.

The dumpsters will be emptied once and can be refilled during this time.

These dumpsters will be available again in the fall.
