REMINDERS

Remember to get your ballot in by November 2nd at 8:00 p.m. for the Municipal Election. You can drop it in the ballot box in the City Hall parking lot. Ballots that are mailed, should be postmarked by November 1st or earlier.



With new homes being built, some residents may not be aware of City code. Here are a few reminders for all home owners.

Creating a second access into your yard requires City permission, whether it is another access from the side, front or back. Depending on the designation of the road you live on, such as local or collector streets, determines if a second access is allowed. Please call the City before creating a second access. You may be required to undo it at your expense.

Cutting into existing curbing around your driveway or yard, also requires City permission. If the cut changes water flow, you will be required to put it back at your expense.

Grantsville City's Annual Light Parade will be held Saturday, November 27th at 6:00 pm!

No need to pre-register, just show up at 5:30 pm at City Hall. The parade route is from City Hall to the Fire Station on Main Street.
