\*It's time for Fall Cleaning! The dumpster program will be offered again around the city for residents to clean up their yards. Please abide by the following rules so we can continue offering these opportunities.

Do not put appliances with freon in the dumpsters. Tires, batteries, oil and hazardous waste are also not accepted. These dumpsters are **not** for regular household garbage that will fit in your can.

Do not put garbage outside of the dumpster. If it is full, wait for it to be emptied before you add to it. Garbage cannot be left after the dumpster is gone.

Dumpsters will be at the following locations and dates:

For residents who live west of Willow Street, there will be a dumpster at the Hollywood Park AND one at the parking lot near the Cemetery on **Sat., Oct. 16th** from 7:00 am until 2:00 pm.

For residents who live east of Willow Street, there will be a dumpster at the corner of North Bowery and Clark Street AND one at the south end of Worthington Street on **Sat., Oct. 30th** from 7:00 am until 2:00 pm.

The dumpsters will be emptied once and can be refilled during this time.
