About Grantsville City

The city of Grantsville is a supportive, family-oriented community that often shows its appreciation for the Police Department making it an enjoyable place to serve - especially in light of the current political climate. A rapidly growing population of approximately 13,000 people call Grantsville home. It is booming with new housing and annexation requests. Some projections show that the city could double in size in five years. Many are attracted to Grantsville's ideal combination of a hospitable, country feel and its proximity to Salt Lake City. You still have the conveniences of the big city but can quickly escape to fresher air and an area better suited to raise a family. Grantsville boasts a plethora of horse and UTV trails, picturesque views of the Stansbury Mountains and the Great Salt Lake and is located just 30 minutes west of downtown Salt Lake City. Grantsville is home to the Utah MotorSports Campus, the host venue for events such as Nitro Circus, NASCAR, and Night Lights. Country Fan Fest is also held here every summer.

Though some commute to Salt Lake City for employment, the Grantsville area is primed for economic opportunity. The commercial landscape is rapidly changing and promises to provide additional revenue for the City. The Romney Group broke ground north of the Purple Mattress Warehouse on December 3, 2020, for Lakeview Business Park, a 1300-acre light industrial manufacturing area. A new I-80 exit, the Mid-Valley Highway, will soon be completed. The exit will not only make the area more attractive for future commercial business but will also provide quick interstate access and expedite commutes to and from the valley. Grantsville is also home to a Wal-Mart Distribution Center.





GRANTSVILLE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT

Due to the projected growth in the area we expect our 17-officer Department to increase in size creating many early opportunities to promote and advance your career. We offer opportunities to specialize including SWAT, CVSA, Tooele County Major Crimes Task Force, Investigations, School Resource Officer, PIO, DRE, and K-9. We encourage lateral transfers and one-year retirees seeking a second law enforcement career and offer higher wages for experienced officers. Though we are getting busier, patrol call load is manageable and ideal for police officers who wish to be proactive in traffic and drug enforcement. Our patrol officers work rotating 12 hour shifts and have every other weekend off. For safety, Chief mandates that we always have at least 2 officers on duty at all times. Patrol officers have their own vehicle and are issued body worn cameras. Our patrol officers work rotating 12 hour shifts and have every other weekend off. Our base of operations is the new Grantsville City Justice Center dedicated in January of 2018.
