PURPOSE OF THE CALLED SPECIAL MEETING: Executive Session – “pursuant to R.C. 121.22(G)(3) to discuss a pending or imminent court action”


EXECUTIVE SESSION: Mrs. McMurry made a motion to adjourn into executive session at 5:46 p.m. to discuss Pending or imminent court action pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section: 121.22 (G)(3) A public body may adjourn into executive session with the public body’s attorney to discuss a pending or imminent court action. Court action is “pending” is a lawsuit has been commenced, and it is “imminent” if it is on the brink of commencing. Courts have concluded that threatened litigation is imminent and may be discussed in executive session. Additionally, a general discussion of legal matters is not a sufficient basis for invoking this provision. Note that a member of a public body is not necessarily the public body’s duly-appointed counsel simply because the member happens to also be an attorney. Mrs. Losey seconded the motion. Vote – yea 5, nay 0. Motion carried.

Return to regular meeting at 5:46 p.m.


