

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Cunliffe, Linton, Lehman, Dora, Moss, and Warner; GARCC Director Berry; and Clerk Rasmussen.

Absent: None

1. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Hoppough.
2. The Statement of Citizens consisted of the following: Shawnee Lenon, 500 N. Lafayette Street, spoke in support of medical marijuana. Nick Miles a marijuana farmer, Lincoln Lake & 12 Mile Rd., spoke in support of marijuana.
3. Councilperson Moss MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

- a. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting on November 05, 2019.

- e. To consider the Mayoral reappointment of Wendy Gladding to the Downtown Development Authority for a four-year term ending December 31, 2023.
- f. To consider the Mayoral reappointment of Amy O'Brien to the Planning Commission for a three-year term ending December 31, 2022.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the recommendation from the Building Inspector and Hearing Officer to demolish the dwelling located at 910 W. Grove Street in the amount of \$13,300 after the 21-day period for the motion to appeal has passed as presented. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

6. Council considered the approval of a recommendation to invest Cemetery Perpetual Care Funds for Forest Home Cemetery.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve a motion to invest the City's Perpetual Care Fund with HV Group of Merrill Lynch out of Portage, Michigan as presented. Councilperson Linton seconded. Unanimously adopted.

7. Council considered the acceptance of a grant award from the Greenville Area Community Foundation for Shakespeare in the Park.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: That Councilperson Moss be allowed to abstain due to an appearance of a conflict of interest. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To accept the proposed grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation in the amount of \$16,950 for Shakespeare in the Park as presented. Adopted with a vote of six ayes from Councilpersons Hoppough, Lehman, Cunliffe, Warner, Dora, and Linton. Councilperson Moss abstained.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.
