

The special meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 6:00 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Cunliffe, Lehman, Barrus, Moss, and Linton; City Manager Bosanic, and Deputy Clerk Hatfield.

1. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Hoppough.

New Business

2. Council considered Resolution 20-04, a resolution authorizing the submission of a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application in the amount of \$1,000,000 in connection with the Wastewater Treatment Plant and authorizing the City Manager to sign all related documentation.

Councilperson Lehman RESOLVED: To approve resolution No. 20-04, a resolution authorizing the submission of a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application in the amount of \$1,000,000 in connection with the Wastewater Treatment Plant and authorizing the City Manager to sign all related documentation:

WHEREAS, the Michigan Strategic Fund has invited Units of General Local Government to apply for its CDBG-Infrastructure and Resiliency (CDBG-IR) Competitive Funding Round; and

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville desires to request One Million dollars (\$1,000,000) in CDBG funds to replace raw influent pumps, construct a secondary digester, install a mixing system and pump in the existing sludge storage and expand the solar panel field; and

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville commits local funds from a bond sale in the amount of One Million Seven Hundred Thousand dollars (\$1,700,000); and

WHEREAS, the proposed project is consistent with the local Community Development Plan as described in the Application; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will benefit all residents of the project area and 52% percent of the residents of the City of Greenville are low and moderate income persons

as determined by an income survey approved by the Michigan Economic Development Corporation; and

WHEREAS, local funds and any other funds to be invested in the project have not been obligated/incurred and will not be obligated/incurred prior to a formal grant award, completion of the environmental review procedures and a formal written authorization to obligate/incur costs from the Michigan Economic Development Corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Greenville hereby designates the City Manager as the Environmental Review Certifying Officer, the person authorized to certify the Michigan CDBG Application, the person authorized to sign the Grant Agreement and payment requests, and the person authorized to execute any additional documents required to carry out and complete the grant.

Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Adopted with a vote of (6) Ayes: Hoppough, Lehman, Cunliffe, Linton, Barrus, and Moss; (0) Nays; and (1) Absent: Scoby.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.
