

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough. This meeting was held virtually via Zoom in Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

3. Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed Telecommunications Permit for Casair Inc. of Stanton, Michigan to locate broadband fiber infrastructure within the City's street rights-of-way as presented. Councilperson Linton seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Roscommon, Michigan meeting specifications in the amount not to exceed \$8,205.00 as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

6. Council considered approving the purchase of additional BS&A software for planning and zoning.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the purchase of additional software modules from BS&A for certain municipal functions in the amount of \$3,770 as presented. Councilperson Linton seconded. Unanimously adopted.
