

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Cunliffe. This meeting was held virtually via Zoom in Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

All council members attended the virtual meeting in Greenville, Montcalm County, Michigan.

3. Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as amended. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.

4. Council considered the approval of the Downtown Development Authority (DDA) 2021-2022 annual budget.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed 2021-2022 Downtown Development Authority fiscal budget as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

5. Council considered proposed Traffic Control Order No. 2021-01 establishing “No Trucks Allowed” signs to prohibit semi-trucks on Edgewood and Cherry Streets from Vandeinse Avenue.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed Traffic Control Order No. 2021-01 establishing “No Trucks Allowed” signs to prohibit semi-trucks on Edgewood and Cherry Streets from Vandense Avenue as presented. Councilperson Linton seconded. Unanimously adopted.

6. Council considered the award of a bid for monthly street sweeping, chip seal sweeping, and special events sweeping of city streets.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for the sweeping of city streets to National Industrial Maintenance, Inc. of Dearborn, Michigan in the amount not to exceed:

Section 1 - \$3,200 per month for the months of June, August, and October

Section 2 - \$2,805 per month for the months of July and September

Section 3 - \$300 per month for the months of June, July, August, September, and October

And

To award a bid for the sweeping of city streets to Sani-Sweep of Grand Rapids, Michigan in the amount not to exceed: \$150 per hour for events and seal coating as presented. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.
