

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Cunliffe in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m. This was a hybrid meeting format, in-person and virtual.

Present: Mayor Cunliffe; Councilpersons Moss, Lehman, Barrus, Linton, Scoby, and Johnson; City Manager Bosanic, Assistant City Manager Feazel, and Clerk-Finance Director Rasmussen. All council members attended the meeting in-person, except Councilperson Linton who attended virtually from Glen Arbor, Grand Traverse County, Michigan.

Absent: None

1. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Cunliffe.
2. The Statement of Citizens: None
3. Councilperson Moss MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as amended. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

- a. Approval of the amended minutes for the regular City Council meeting on July 20, 2021.
- b. Approval of the payroll report for the regular pay period ending July 10, 2021, in the amount of \$138,536.61.
- c. Approval of the accounts payable report for the period ending July 23, 2021, in the amount of \$373,376.06.
- d. Approval of the minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held June 24, 2021.
- e. Information on training opportunities provided.

New Business

4. Council considered a recommendation from the Downtown Development Authority to remove the tree in front of Flos Restaurant.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To request the Downtown Development Authority to create a three-to-five-year plan to remove and replace the trees downtown. Councilperson Barrus seconded. Unanimously adopted.

5. Council considered a revised street closure request in connection with the Chamber Business Expo Thursday, September 30, 2021.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the following request for street closures and park use for the proposed Business Expo:

- Closure of M-91 (Lafayette) between M-57 (Washington) and Montcalm Street on Thursday, September 30th at 2:00 p.m. and opening at 9:00 p.m.
- Closing of Cass and Grove Street at both sides of Lafayette to the park lot entrances.
- Lafayette Street Park Tent set up on Thursday, September 30th at noon and removed no later than noon on Friday, October 1st.
- The event must follow current COVID-19 CDC guidelines.

Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

6. Council considered authorizing the mayor and clerk to sign the Utility Services Agreement with Eureka Charter Township.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed Water and Sewer Services Agreement with Eureka Charter Township and ratify the Mayor and Clerk’s signature as presented. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.

7. Council considered the award of a bid for the purchase of three copy machines.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of three copy machines to Ricoh USA, Inc. of Malvern, PA in the amount not to exceed \$15,649.00 with an average monthly maintenance charge of \$242.74 for an estimated 60 months as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

8. Council considered the purchase of a ball field paint striper.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To award the bid for the purchase of a ball field paint striper to Epic Sports Inc. of Bel Aire, KS in the amount not to exceed \$10,813.79 as presented. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.
