

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Cunliffe in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m. This was a hybrid meeting format, in-person and virtual.

Present: Mayor Cunliffe; Councilpersons Moss, Lehman, Barrus, Linton, and Johnson; City Manager Bosanic, Assistant Manager Feazel, Clerk-Finance Director Rasmussen and Public Safety Director Magirl. All council members attended the meeting in person.

Absent: Councilperson Scoby.

1. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Cunliffe.
2. The Statement of Citizens: Shawne Bonner, 500 N. Lafayette Street, spoke regarding the lack of progress on the Marijuana Ordinances.
3. Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

5. Council considered purchasing a new credit card fuel system for the Greenville Municipal Airport.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase and installation of a new credit card fuel system for the Greenville Municipal Airport to ROHR Gasoline Equipment Inc. of Byron Center, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$16,649.00 as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

6. Council considered the approval of Resolution No. 21-19, a resolution for the City of Greenville to join with the Ray I Booth American Legion Post 101 in declaring November 2021, “Do Business with a Veteran Month”.

8. Council considered allocating \$528,000 of the Capital Improvement Fund Balance for the grinder pump replacement.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve allocating \$528,000 of the Capital Improvement Fund Balance for the Baldwin Lake Grinder Pump replacement program and charge a 1.75% interest rate as presented. Councilperson Linton seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council Person Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.
