

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Cunliffe in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m. This was a hybrid meeting format, in-person and virtual.

Present: Mayor Cunliffe; Councilpersons Scoby, Moss, Barrus, Linton, and Johnson; City Manager Bosanic, Assistant Manager Feazel, and Clerk-Finance Director Rasmussen All council members attended the meeting in person.

Absent: Councilperson Lehman.

1. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Cunliffe.
2. The Statement of Citizens: None
3. Councilperson Moss MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

4. Council considered the award of a bid for the sale of the 2014 Dodge Caravan from the Transit Department.

Council Johnson MOVED: to award the sale of a city-owned 2014 Dodge Caravan to James Bowers of Stanton, Michigan in the amount of \$27,000 as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

5. Council considered the award of a bid for the construction of a lean-to for the transit building.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: to award a bid for the construction of a “lean-to” on the Transit building to Brandon Phillips – PG Skilled Trades/ABC Carpentry of Stanton, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$5,000 as presented. Councilperson Linton seconded. Unanimously adopted.

6. Council considered the approval of a traffic control order to rescind TCO 76-02 YIELD signs at Lincoln Street at W. Judd Street and establish TCO 2021-07 for STOP signs.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: to approve Traffic Control Order 2021-07 to rescind required YIELD signs on Lincoln Street at West Judd Street ordered per TCO No. 76-02 and replace the same with STOP signs due to restricted vision as presented. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.
